MORPHINE SULPHATE INJECTORS


S/L Root referred to previous action on this matter as a result of which a D.O.S. Permit was issued to ~~cover~~ ^{import} a quantity of morphine sulphate auto injectors 20mg from Cambridge Self Care Diagnostics. A complication has arisen in that Cambridge is shifting its manufacturing facility for the morphine product to California and it will be some months before their product is available. S/L Root now needed to obtain from Holland a further supply of 1200 morphine sulphate auto injectors 10 mg to cover the present emergency. The supplier will be

I discussed this with [redacted] of DODS and, in the absence of both [redacted] and [redacted] we agreed that if one permit had been issued, which would not be acted upon, there would be no problem with the issue of a second permit, under the same conditions i.e. not for distribution in Australia and as no data had been presented to the Department for evaluation, no guarantee could be given of quality, safety and efficacy.

Subsequently the courier, a RAAMC sergeant, arrived with the attached letter. I copied same and directed him to DODS to collect the permit.
