# Local Government Area (LGA) COVID-19 Vaccine Rates

24 November 2022

## Data caveats

### Note on areas with large remote and very remote areas:

The process of geocoding addresses in very remote areas and remote areas can lead to artificially low vaccine dose count records in those areas (as addresses cannot be 'pinpointed' to a specific client location, and therefore LGA). The areas have been highlighted to indicate they are remote or very remote.

### Methodology underpinning LGA Remoteness classification:

LGA 'remoteness' is calculated by assigning a modal remoteness value for each LGA, based on where the majority of the population in each LGA live - using 2021 Census meshblock population counts. Remote and Very Remote classifications accord with the same values if using the Modified Monash Model of remoteness.

Population cell values less than 200 have been suppressed for Privacy. Similarly, Coverage rates have been suppressed for regions with populations under 20.
