










Doses Reported





Number of people vaccinated by age




Individuals vaccinated by residential location


Identifying as Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander is optional and the estimated population may be under reported. Numbers include all Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander peoples who have received a vaccination, and are not limited to those administered in an ACCHS setting. The total population refers to the number of individuals that identify as Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander in the Australian Immunisation Register, while the eligible population refers to the number of these individuals who meet the criteria for a further dose (based on completion of previous doses, age, and time period elapsed since last dose). Please note there may be people under 30 who are eligible, but these are not included in coverage rates or population to protect privacy.

#ACCHS in the ACT are currently operating as Commonwealth Vaccine Clinics so not included to avoid double counting.




