1.1 Schedule of price reductions

- Prostheses Listings are to have their benefit levels referenced to the respective 1.1.1 public prices from 1 July 2022 until 30 June 2026. Under this approach:
 - devices with a small gap between the Prostheses List benefit and Weighted (a) Average Price, judged to be less than 7 percent above the Weighted Average Price, would not be reduced; and
 - devices with a gap of more than 7 percent above between the Prostheses (b) List benefit and the Weighted Average Price would not reduce below 7 percent above the Weighted Average Price. The 7 percent floor for all products is to remain for the period of the reforms specified in this section 2.1.1 and not be contingent on any review.

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
