National Health Amendment (General co-payment) Bill 2022

On behalf of the Pharmacy Guild of Australia, I would like to congratulate you on your speech in the House of Representatives in support of the National Health Amendment (General co-payment) Bill 2022.

In rising to speak on this amendment, you have become part of the history that has seen the single most significant change to the cost of, and access to, medicines since the PBS was introduced 75 years ago.

You have helped countless families across the country to once again be better able to afford the medicines they need. You have helped to initiate the first major step in returning universal access to the PBS, a tenet that is so fundamental to our health system.

The Pharmacy Guild of Australia drove the advocacy for the co-payment reduction because our members were increasingly being confronted by patients unable to afford their medicines or having to choose which medicines they could afford to buy, and which they could leave out. Heartbreakingly, some were having to choose which of their children might not get their medicines.

On behalf of all our members I thank you for your support and for your commitment to the health of Australians. This is a first step and there is work we can do.

I look forward to working with you so we can achieve full and equitable access to medicines for all Australians and would appreciate the opportunity to meet with you at your convenience.

Dear Assistant Minister,

On behalf of the Pharmacy Guild of Australia, I would like to applaud the Government's initiative in setting up the new National Women's Health Advisory Council, and to you in your role Chairing the Council.

Community pharmacies are integral to the delivery of better health outcomes for women and girls in Australia. Not only are community pharmacies the most frequently accessed and most accessible health destination, with over 462.6 million individual patient visits annually and 2,135 pharmacies open after-hours, including weekends, but as of 30 September 2022, there were 35,173 registered pharmacists in Australia. 63.8% of pharmacists are women; and about 58% are under 40 years of age.

You would also be aware of recent clinical developments for women such as advice and treatment of UTIs in pharmacy and with women aged between 18 and 35 getting renewed access to the contraceptive pill if they've had a prescription in the past two years.

Community pharmacies have a unique insight into the challenges women and girls experience in the health system, and the Guild would like to propose Amanda Seeto, Vice-President of The Pharmacy Guild of Australia Queensland Branch and national Councillor to be invited to join the National Women's Health Advisory Council.
