

NEW OUTBREAK SUPPORTS - from 1 Jan to 31 Dec 2024

Aged Care Outbreak Management Supplement

- Replaces the COVID-19 grants from 1 Jan 2024 for all residential providers.
 - Paid automatically to all residential providers, no need to apply
 - Support pro-active planning and outbreak preparedness
- Contribution to outbreak management costs
 Continued support especially for rural and remote and First Nations
 - Time limited, rapid deployment to homes with critical workforce shortages.
- Supports at-risk providers experiencing outbreak or other emergency

Infection prevention and control (IPC)

- · Continued to access to IPC resources and online training
 - · Continued surveillance and monitoring activities
- Undertake IPC research and evaluation, including of IPC lead Nurse

PPE and RAT kits

- Final deployment of PPE packs ahead of Christmas.
- Access to PPE Packs on request and weekly deployment of RAT kits from the NMS to 30 April 2024.

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
COVID-19 Aged Care Support Program – Extension Grant

- Grant reimburses approved aged care providers for eligible expenditure incurred in managing direct impacts of COVID-19 up to a maximum grant value per service.
- Grant opened 4 June 2021 and closed 31 March 2023.
- 11,383 applications were received.
- All applications have been assessed.

2023 COVID-19 Aged Care **Support Program Grant**

- Grant reimburses approved aged care providers to maintain preparedness for, and respond to, outbreaks between 1 January 2023 and 31 December 2023 for eligible expenses associated with managing a COVID-19 outbreak.
- Grant opened 26 April 2023 and closes 3 April 2024
- Grant will include:
 - o capped funding per application based on the number of operational places or number of clients for home care services
 - o targeted support through invitation only applications for significant and extended outbreaks, or where identified providers have participated in an outbreak prevention audit conducted by Aspen through the IPC In-reach Appraisal Project.

2023 COVID-19 Aged Care Support Program Application Status



Key improvements to application processing

- Resident isolation dates must be clear on the test register
- Avoid using acronyms.
- Ensure items claimed are eligible
- Where including additional information it should be succinct, of relevance and clear.

Aged Care Worker COVID-19 Leave Payment Grant

Grant reimburses approved residential and home care providers for sick leave payments
for directly employed permanent and casual workers, where the eligible employee is
unable to attend work due to a COVID-19 infection and has insufficient sick leave

Reimbursement amounts	Leave Hour Bracket
\$450 per worker	Where the worker has lost at least 8 hours and up to and including 20 hours of work over a 7 calendar day period (or less)
\$750 per worker	Where the worker has lost more than 20 hours of work over a 7 calendar day period (or less)
