Why does the department collect your personal information?	<p>We collect personal information for the purpose of registering you to attend a Medical Costs Finder digital information session on Webex.</p> <p>When you register, you will be required to indicate your:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• name• email <p>You may also be asked to specify your:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• job title• practice/company/organisation• phone number• state/territory where you are located• where you heard about the digital session. <p>Some questions may be optional. Unless the question is mandatory, you can answer as many applicable questions as you are comfortable with.</p> <p>Your personal information may also be used for other purposes such as:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• informing you about future events or updates• helping us understand who participates in each digital session• providing follow-up resources from the registered digital session.
What would happen if the department did not collect your personal information?	If you do not or are unable to provide your personal information the department will be unable to register you to attend the digital session.

Who will the department disclose your personal information to?	We will not disclose your personal information to third party recipient entities, bodies or persons.
Access to and correction of your personal information	<p>The department's privacy policy contains information about how you may access and seek correction of personal information about you that is held by the department.</p> <p>You can contact us to access your personal information or correct it.
