

FIRST NATIONS HEALTH FUNDING TRANSITION ADVISORY GROUP

Communique

13 June 2024

The First Nations Health Funding Transition Advisory Group met virtually on 13 June 2024. The meeting was chaired by David Hicks, First Assistant Secretary, Financial Management Division, Department of Health and Aged Care.

Analysis and discussion of opportunities

A marathon session of the Advisory Group saw a further 12 programs analysed by Members to determine the potential transition of program activities to the community controlled sector.

Continuing the momentum from the last Advisory Group meeting on 9 May 2024 where eight programs were considered, the Group discussed each program against a prioritisation framework which included readiness and willingness to transition.

The Advisory Group provided key insight which shaped understanding for future program activities and made recommendations for transition.

Regular meetings will take place through June culminating in an all program review scheduled for July with a roadmap for transition to be developed at that time.
