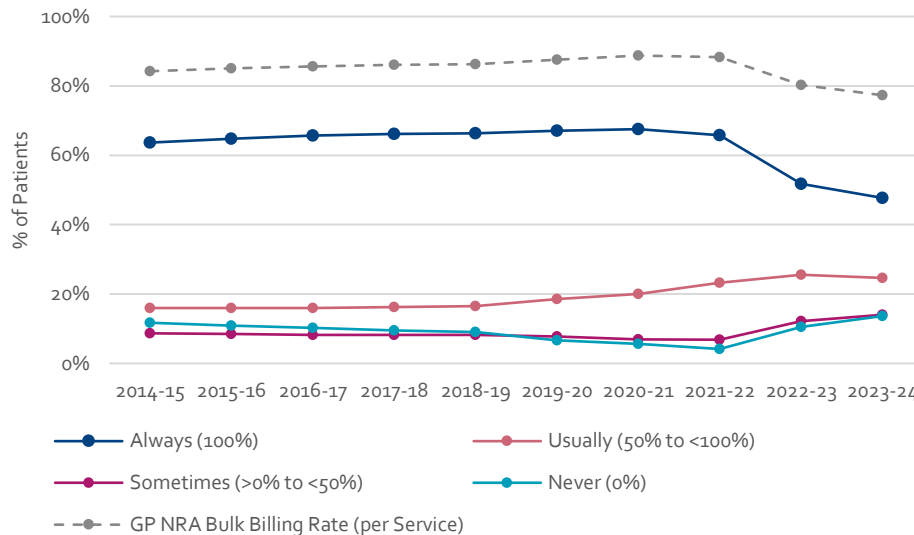

Many patients have more than one GP NRA service during the year. This page shows the proportion of patients who were always, usually, sometimes, or never bulk billed across **all** of their GP NRA services.

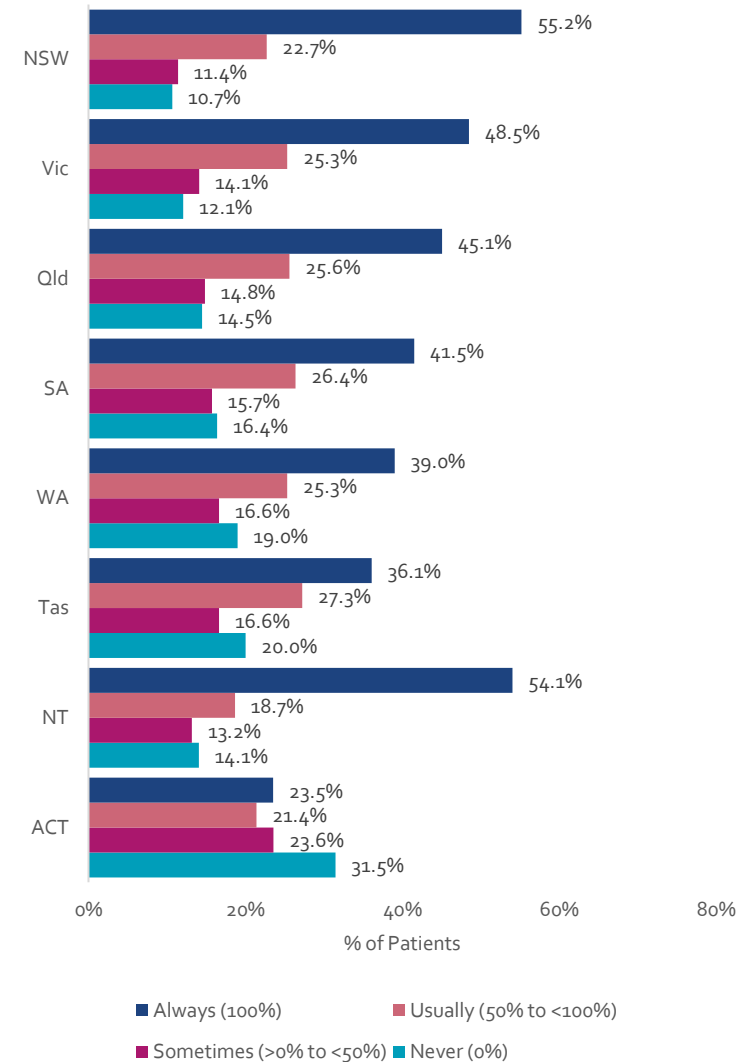
In 2023-24, the proportion of GP NRA patients who were always or usually bulk billed **decreased from 77.3% to 72.4%** while the proportion of patients who were never bulk billed **increased from 10.5% to 13.6%**.

How often are GP NRA patients bulk billed?



The proportion of patients always (100%) bulk billed tends to be lower than the bulk billing rate because patients with, for example, 9 out of 10 services (90%) bulk billed are classified as “usually” bulk billed.

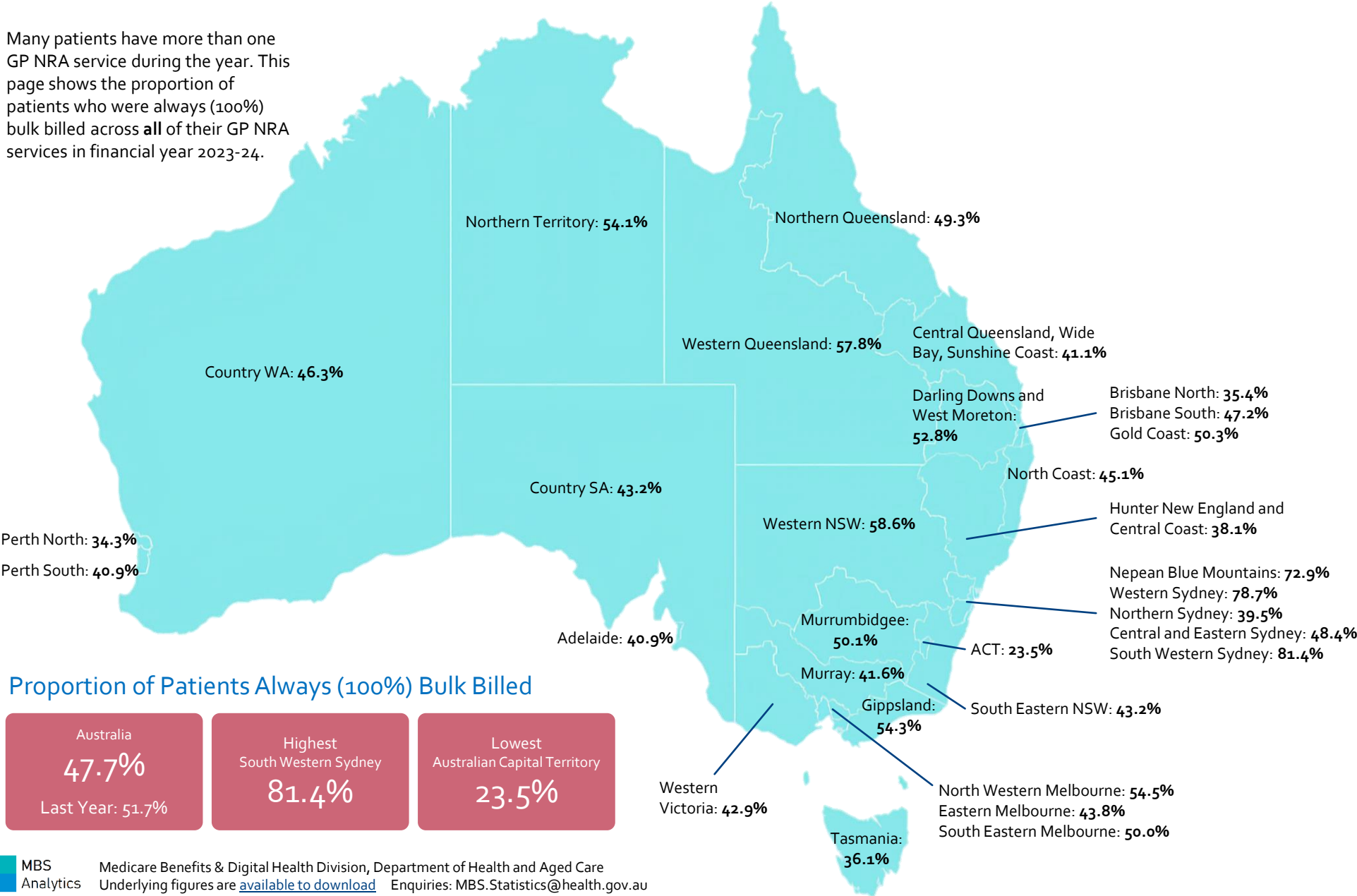
GP NRA Patient Bulk Billing Ranges by State and Territory, 2023-24



# GP Non-Referred Attendances – per Patient 100% Bulk Billing by PHN, 2023-24

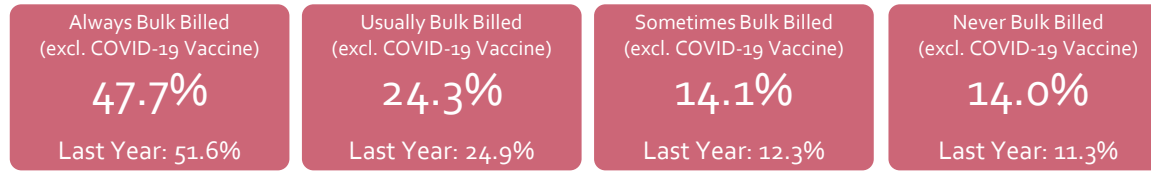

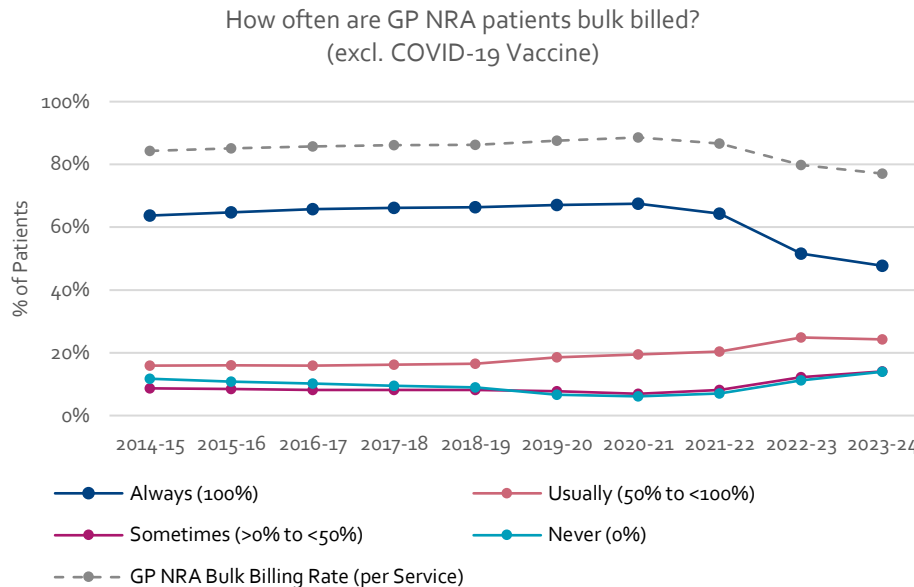
# GP Non-Referred Attendances (GP NRA) per Patient Bulk Billing Ranges, 2023-24

(excluding temporary COVID-19 Vaccines items)



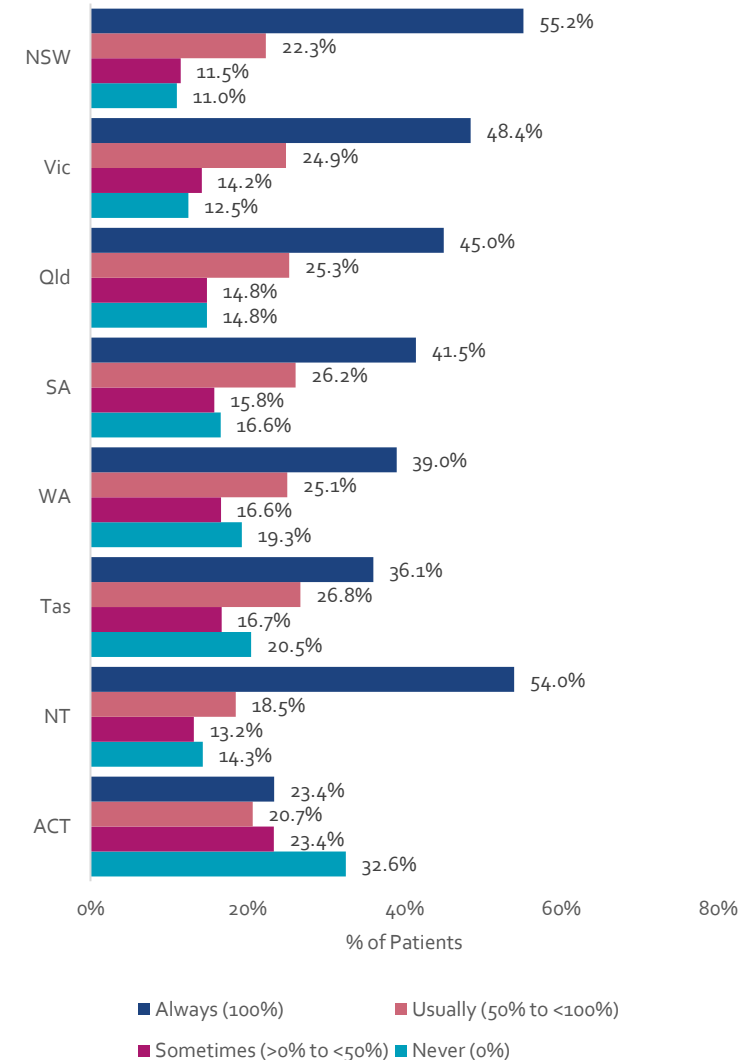
COVID-19 vaccine items were introduced in late February 2021 and had peak usage in the 2021-22 financial year. As bulk billing for COVID-19 vaccine items is mandatory, they impacted the bulk billing rate. This page shows the proportion of patients who were: always, usually, sometimes, or never bulk billed across their GP NRA services **excluding** COVID-19 vaccines.

In 2023-24, the proportion of GP NRA patients who were always or usually bulk billed **decreased from 76.5% to 72.0%** while the proportion of patients who were never bulk billed **increased from 11.3% to 14.0%**.



The proportion of patients always (100%) bulk billed tends to be lower than the bulk billing rate because patients with, for example, 9 out of 10 services (90%) bulk billed are classified as "usually" bulk billed.
