Freedom of Information Request 5369

1. Number of import license applications received by the Office of Drug Control between 1 January 2023 and 27 August 2024, for schedule 4 nicotine vaping products:

70 license applications have been received between 1 January 2023 and 27 August 2024.

Regulation 5A of the Customs (Prohibited Imports) Regulations 1956 does not distinguish between schedule 4 nicotine vaping products and other vaping goods. License applications may be for vaping goods such as nicotine free vapes, herbal vaporizers, parts.

2. Number of import license applications that have been approved by ODC between 1 January 2023 and 27 August 2024, for schedule 4 nicotine vaping products:

57 import licenses have been approved between 1 January 2023 and 27 August 2024 under Regulation 5A of the Customs (Prohibited Imports) Regulations 1956.

3. Number of import license applications have been declined by ODC between 1 January 2023 and 27 August 2024, for schedule 4 nicotine vaping products:
