



## Getting more than 1 vaccine at a time



This information is about when your child gets more than 1 **vaccine** at a time.




**Vaccines** are medicines that can help stop children getting sick.



Children get the vaccine

• With a needle in their arm or leg

• Or drops in their mouth.



Most of the time children get vaccines from a

Doctor

Nurse

• Health worker.



Sometimes your child might get more than 1 vaccine at a time.



This might be if there is more than 1 vaccine your child needs at their age.



There are different ways children can get more than 1 vaccine at a time.



Your child might get 2 or more vaccines in 1 needle.



Or your child might get 2 or more vaccines in different needles at the same time.

## **Getting more than 1 vaccine is safe**



You might worry if it is safe for your child to get more than 1 vaccine at the same time.



It is safe for a child to have more than 1 vaccine at the same time.



This is because their **immune system** is very strong.



An **immune system** is the part of the body that keeps them from getting very sick.

## Good things about getting more than 1 vaccine at a time



There are good things about having more than 1 vaccine at the same time.



It means the vaccines will make your childs immune system stronger.



It means children can stay safe from many different **diseases**.



**Diseases** are things your body gets that make you sick.



It also means they do not have to go the doctor as much.
