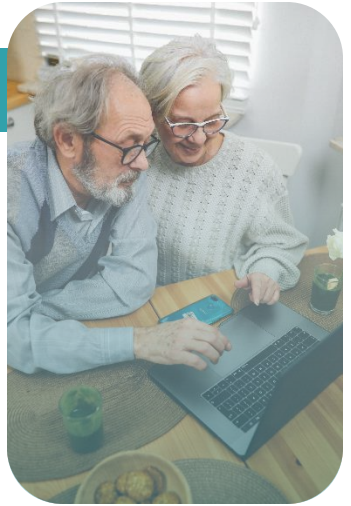

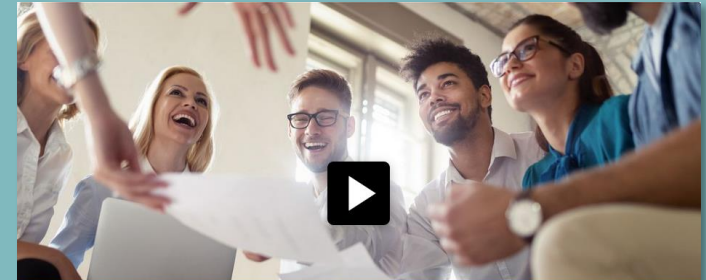
# Important considerations

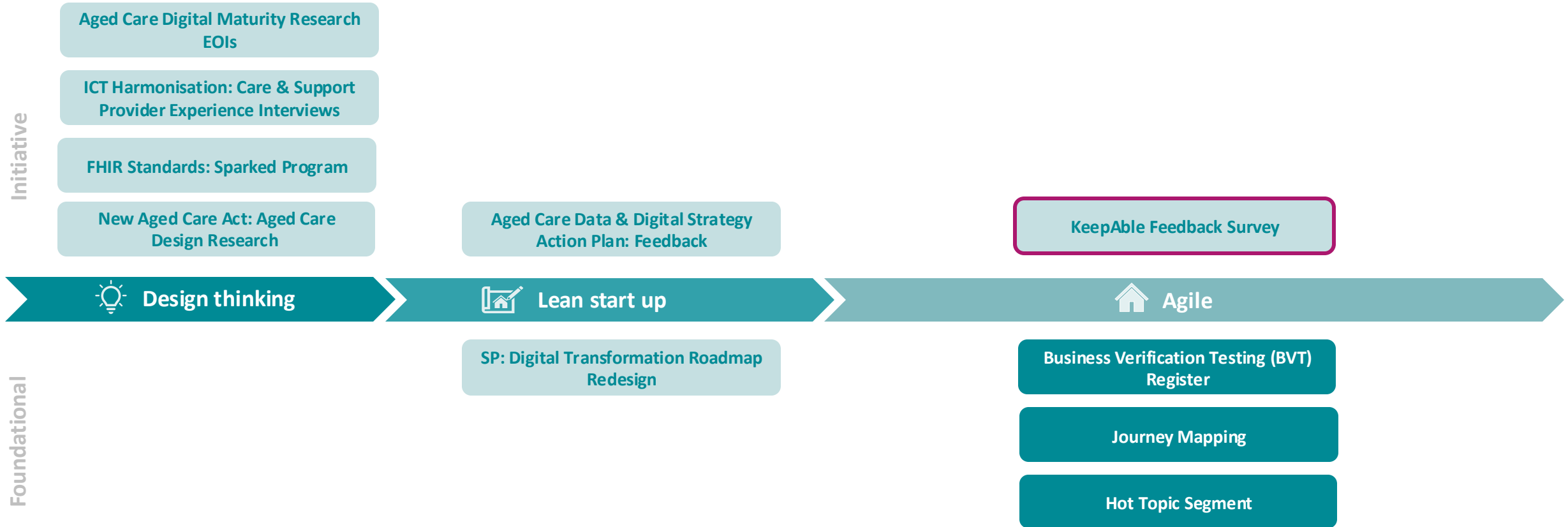

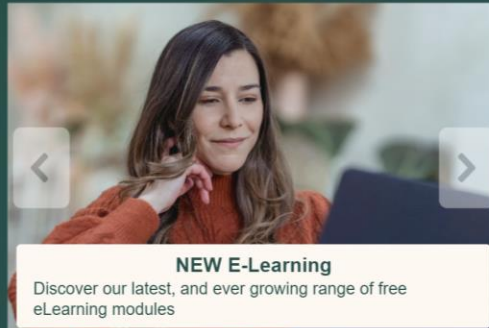

B2G continue to enhance technological connections between aged care providers and Government agencies, aimed at improving data and information.

The B2G project plans to implements up to five additional APIs within the next two years.

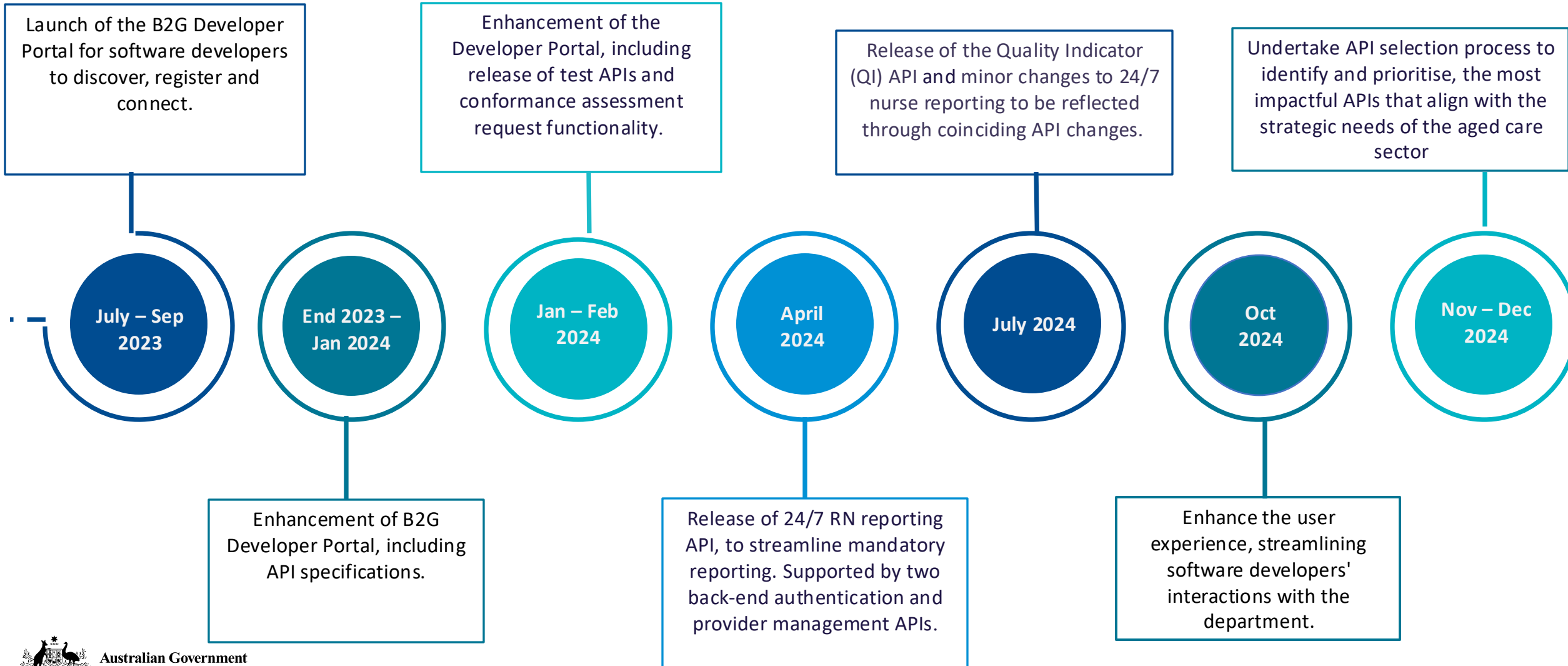
B2G conducted an API survey in July seeking feedback from aged care providers and software vendors to inform the development of five additional APIs.

B2G engaged an independent group to conduct consultation workshops that were:

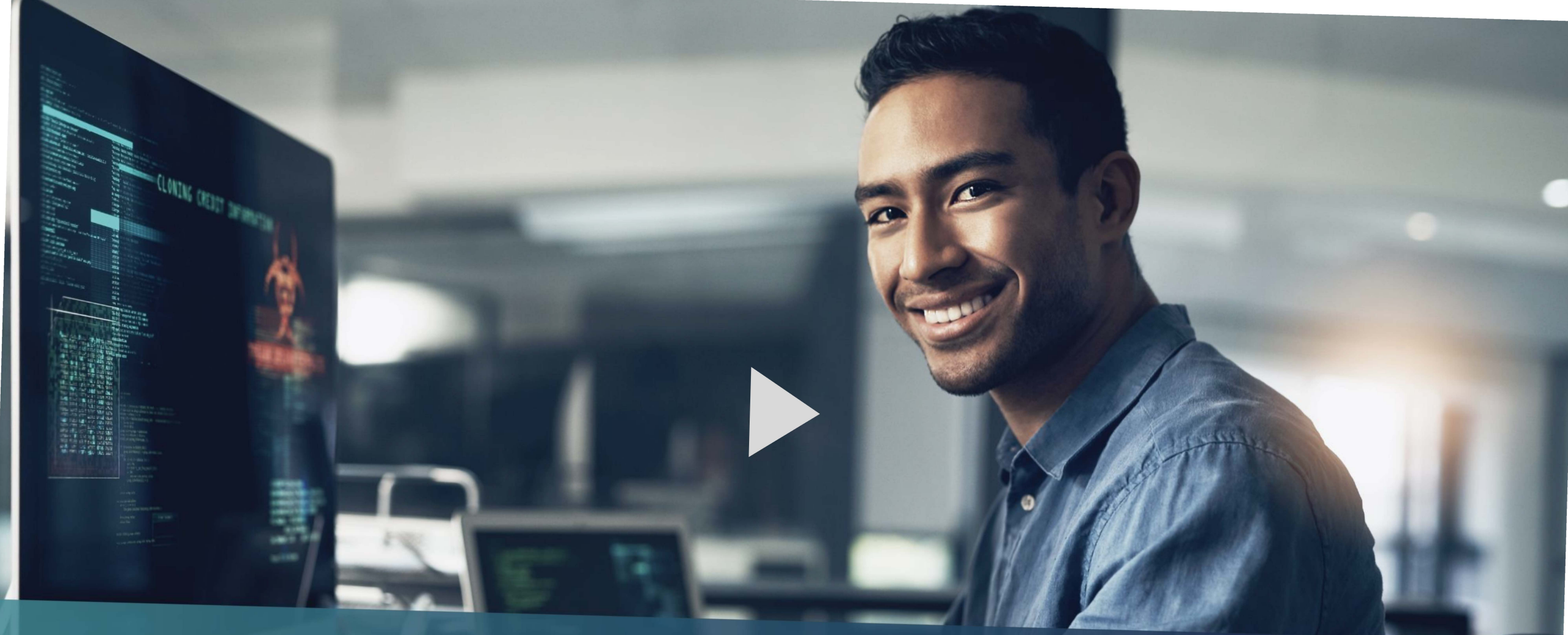
- provider and data driven
