Recommendation**That AHPPC Members:**

Purpose of Paper

To provide members an update on the *Biotoxins (indoor damp and mould) Clinical Pathway* (Biotoxins Clinical Pathway).

Summary of issues for discussion**Finalisation of the Biotoxins Clinical Pathway**

- The Biotoxins Clinical Pathway (**Attachment A**) was recently finalised in consultation with the Biotoxin-related Illnesses Advisory Committee (BIAC).

Publication of the Biotoxins Clinical Pathway

- The Department will seek Ministerial agreement to publish the Biotoxins Clinical Pathway. Both resources are expected to be published on Department's website in coming months.
- Once published, Members will receive a weblink to the Biotoxins Clinical pathway and Evidence Evaluation report to share with their networks.

Key features of the final Biotoxins Clinical Pathway

- **Clinical algorithm and a summary section increase usefulness for busy medical practitioners**
 - The Biotoxins Clinical Pathway includes a 'clinical algorithm' or flow chart to support GPs in decision making on differential diagnosis and referral pathways.
 - This graphic format guides medical professionals with the evaluation, diagnosis and management of the clinical problem.
 - It serves to organise thoughts in a logical and visible way and provides a stepwise guide to medical professionals for patient care.
 - It is included in the Clinical Pathway to assist in the delivery of high-quality health care as a mechanism to improve health outcomes and variations in clinical practice related to biotoxin-related illnesses.

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- The Biotoxins Clinical Pathway includes a 'summary information' section to increase the utility and usability for busy medical practitioners. The summary section has information on initial assessment, patient management diagnostic testing and differential diagnosis. Hyperlinks are included within the 'clinical algorithm' and 'summary information' section to link the relevant sections of the main body of the Biotoxins Clinical Pathway to increase utility.
- **Provides information to support vulnerable and susceptible population**
 - The Biotoxins Clinical Pathway includes information on managing individuals with pre-existing health conditions (for example, allergies, severe asthma or lung diseases) who may be more likely to experience symptoms associated with exposure to indoor damp or mould or poor indoor air quality.
 - Additionally, the Biotoxins Clinical Pathway includes information to support people living in vulnerable circumstances (for example, low socio-economic communities), who may be more susceptible to exposure to indoor damp and mould and potential health effects due to poorly maintained housing and air quality.
- **Includes advice from the enHealth factsheet on mould to help patients**
 - In 2022, enHealth published a factsheet designed for the general public on the potential health effects of mould in the environment. The factsheet provides advice on how to clean mould and information about where to seek further help.
 - The Biotoxins Clinical Pathway includes advice from the enHealth factsheet and specific guidance to GPs to "Provide patients with a hard copy of the enHealth factsheet on mould". The enHealth factsheet is also included as an appendix to the revised Clinical Pathway to assist medical professionals.

Background

- The Australian Government Department of Health and Aged Care (the Department) commissioned the development of the Biotoxins Clinical Pathway in response to a recommendation from the House of Representatives Standing Committee on Health, Aged Care and Sport *Inquiry into Biotoxin-related illnesses in Australia*.
- Further details about the work and the Biotoxins Clinical Pathway were provided to members in November 2022.
- The Biotoxins Clinical Pathway underwent a six-week, online targeted stakeholder consultation in October and November 2022, with stakeholder feedback incorporated into the final product.

Thanks for the opportunity to provide feedback on the *Biotoxins (indoor damp and mould) Clinical Pathway*.

Victoria notes the finalisation of the pathway and offers the following comments:

- Content on the causal relationship between mould and health outcomes lacks some clarity and may be the source of confusion or controversy.
- This is predominantly related to the use of the term 'causal association' which appears to be somewhere between 'association' and 'causation' and potentially some differentiation between asthma causation and exacerbation.
- Further clarity, perhaps in a glossary or box regarding definitions, would be beneficial.

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Dear AHPPC Secretariat

The background review is very extensive and valuable. However, the clinical pathway itself would benefit from further review.

NSW Health recommends that the following matters are reviewed:

1. Entry point and flow. The entry point for the pathway is not clear and the flow through the pathway is not clear.
2. The statement that "patients may be on multiple parts of the pathway simultaneously" is not clear. A pathway can have loops that take a person back to different parts of the path, but they ideally should not be on different parts simultaneously.
3. Consider how the pathway could be more closely aligned to the real-life clinical pathways that GPs and patients are likely to be on when dealing with conditions that relate to damp and mould.
4. Consider developing a very simple overview pathway which shows the different conceptual parts, which can then have a more detailed pathway to refer to.
