







GP NRA Bulk Billing Rate












GP Non-Referred Attendances – Bulk Billing Rate by PHN, 2022-23 Jul-Jun YTD






GP NRA Services by Type, Jul-Jun YTD

In 2022-23 Jul-Jun YTD, the **GP NRA bulk** billing rate in the most disadvantaged areas was 89.4%, 9.2% percentage points higher than the national GP NRA bulk billing rate of 80.2% for the same period.





As SEIFA indexes are assigned to areas, and not individuals, indexes indicate the average socio-economic characteristics of people, families and households living in the area.


GP NRA Services by SEIFA Disadvantage Quintile by Age Group, Jul-Jun YTD
