## **MAP**



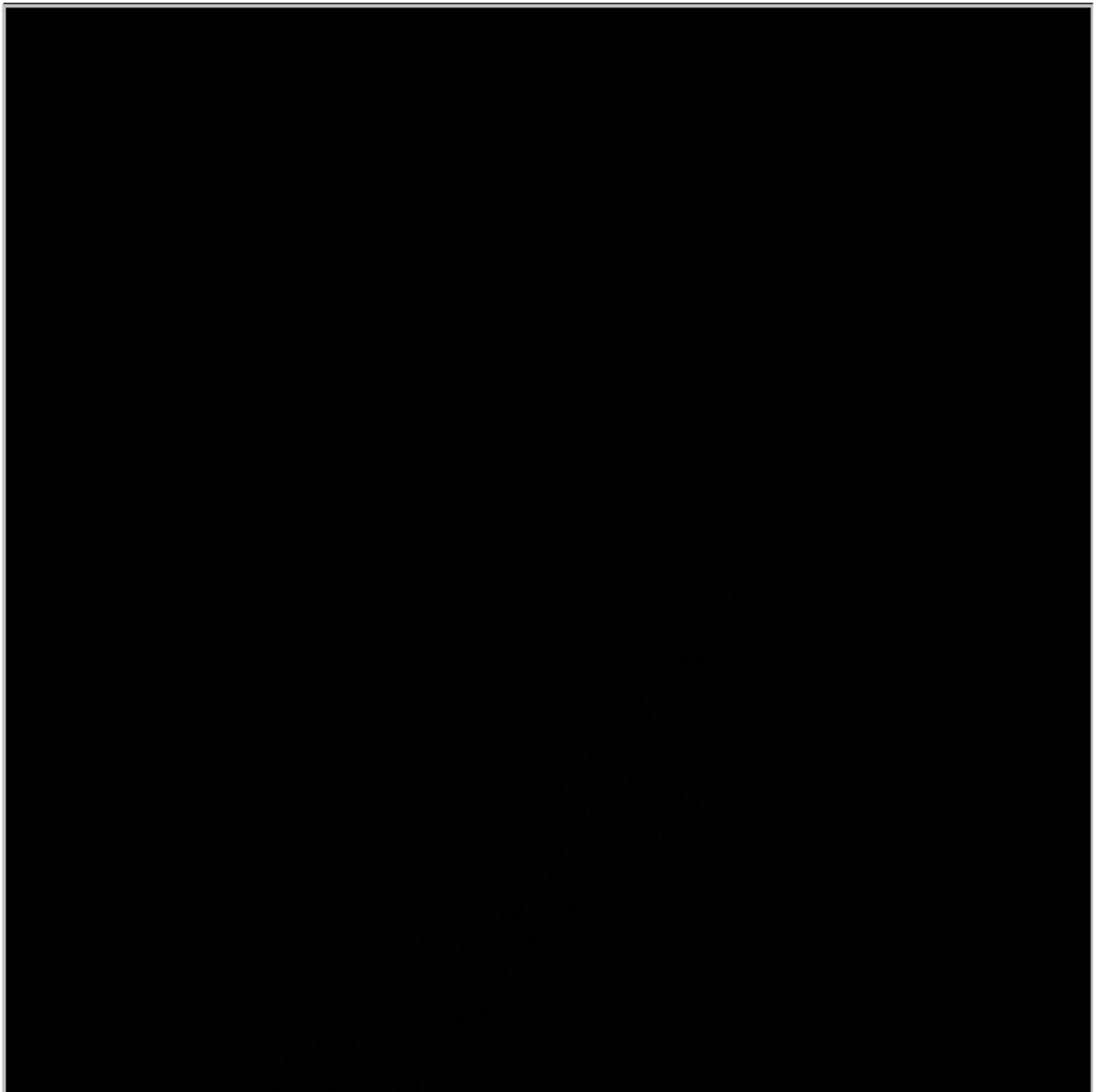
