



Australian Immunisation Register – Influenza Data – 1 March to 1 April

Notes and Caveats										
<div>- All data is based on influenza vaccinations reported to the Australian Immunisation Register (AIR) as at COB 1 April 2025.</div> <div>- Data is from 1 March to 1 April for each encounter year.</div> <div>- Influenza vaccination data is not directly comparable across years due to a range of factors, including:<div>- The impact of the COVID-19 pandemic and national and local responses to the pandemic over time</div><div>- Early in the influenza season, the timing of seasonal events such as Easter</div><div>- Timing of vaccines provided by pharmaceutical companies for clearance through the Therapeutic Goods Administration (TGA)</div><div>- Supply of vaccines and commencement of flu season.</div></div> <div>- Vaccinations where the person has since been 'End dated' in the Medicare Consumer Directory (due to death, emigration, etc) are included in the data.</div> <div>- Data includes influenza vaccinations given to Medicare eligible and non-Medicare eligible individuals.</div> <div>- The counted values represent a count of all vaccination episodes.</div> <div>- A 'Vaccination episode' is linked to a State or Territory based on the vaccinated individuals Medicare residential address at the time of the report's creation.</div>
