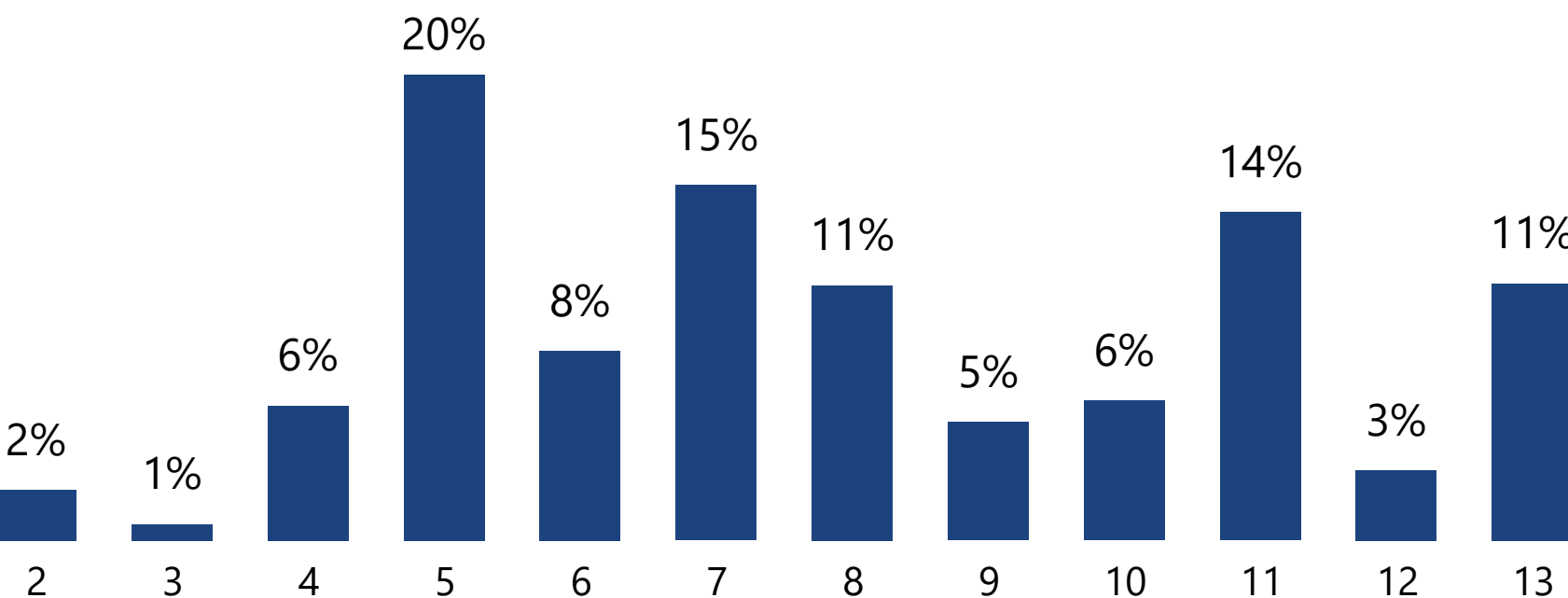

AN-ACC Classification Distribution for Residents In Care



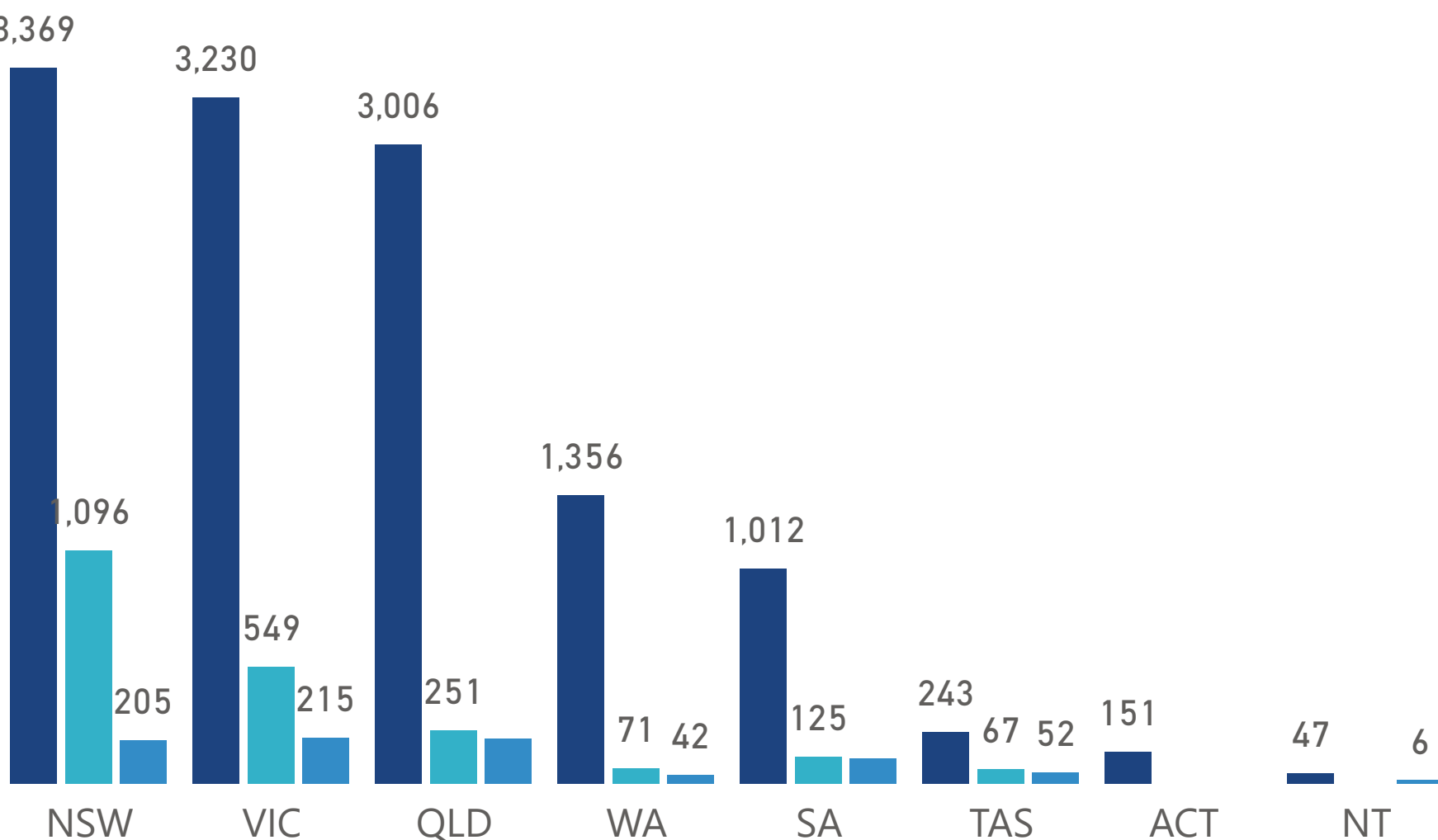

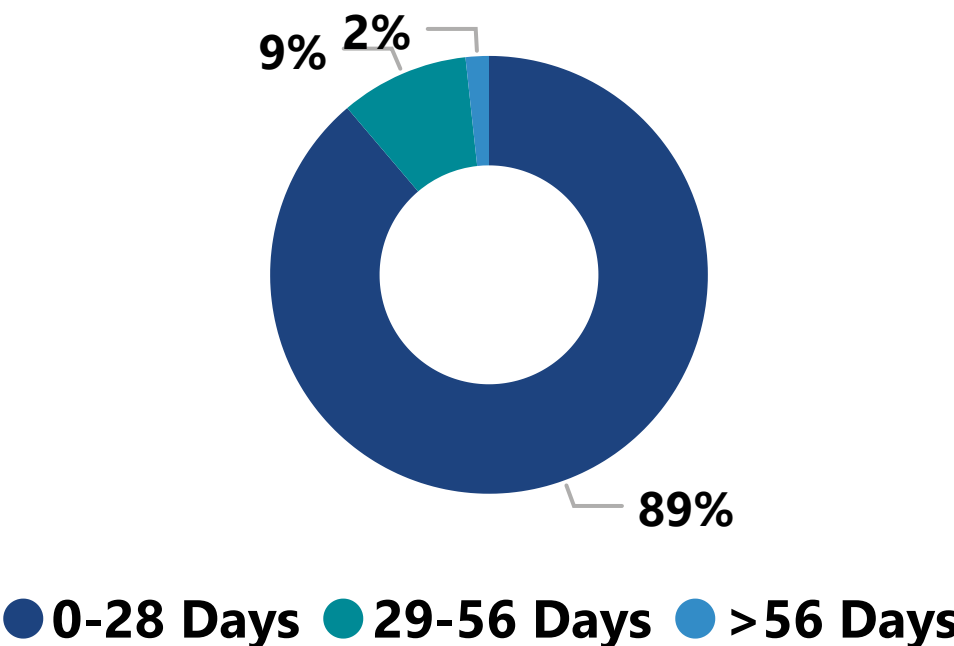

Monthly Highlights

- Residents in care with a classification of 5 represents 20% and the largest proportion of all residents in care.
- As a proportion of all assessments, Reconsideration numbers continue to increase each quarter.
- Only a little over 2% of assessments were completed outside of KPI time frames and this number continues to trend down.
