Alternatively, we welcome your feedback (in track changes please) to ensure both parties are comfortable with the Schedule prior to signing. The draft Schedule is based on previous schedules under the MoU for similar guideline work, as well as the Project Plan and Budget submitted by NHMRC to the Department on 11 and 12 February 2025, respectively.

Please note that the Schedule will not be binding, and no legal obligations shall arise unless and until the Department signs the Schedule.

# **Caretaker**

As you will be aware, the Government is now operating in caretaker mode. In line with the Department of Prime Minister and Cabinet's <u>guidance on caretaker conventions</u>, we have made a determination that the steps to formalise arrangements between our organisations can continue. We consider this undertaking a routine matter of administration because:

- 1. Funding was already approved by the Minister prior to an election being called
- 2. The relatively small dollar amount associated with the undertaking
- 3. The development of clinical practice guidelines is within NHRMC's statutory remit, and funding will remain within the health portfolio
- 4. The project maintains in-principle support from the Opposition Leader, as per his <u>public</u> <u>statements</u> on 2 February 2025 (relevant statements from the Opposition Leader are toward the very end of the transcript).

Please let me know if you have any questions or concerns with this assessment. It goes without saying, but all decisions and actions relating to this project should be undertaken in line with caretaker conventions.
