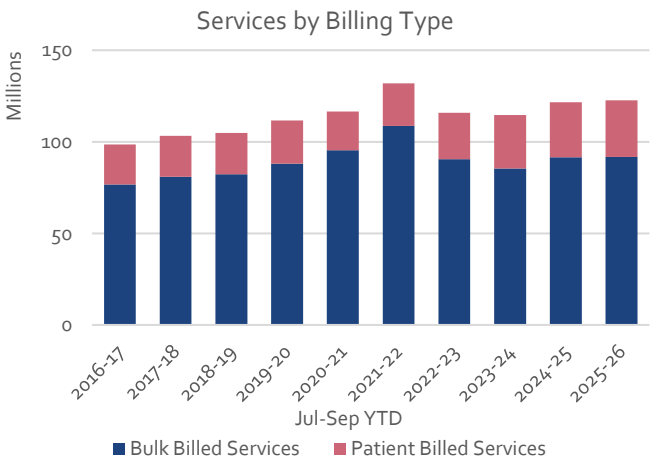

Medicare subsidises the cost of medical services listed in the Medicare Benefits Schedule. In 2025-26 Jul-Sep YTD, total Medicare **services increased from 121.6m to 122.7m**, whilst **total benefits paid increased from \$8.3b to \$8.7b**.

Bulk billed services are provided at no cost to the patient. The bulk billing rate is defined as bulk billed services divided by total services.

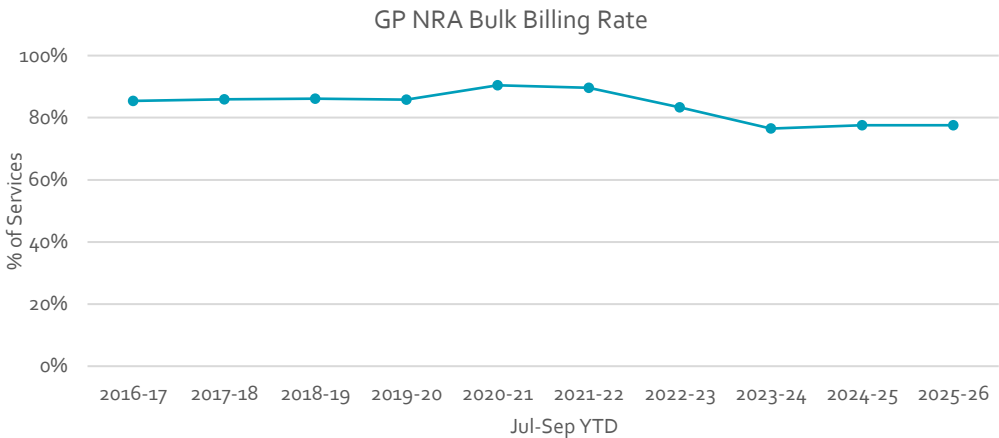
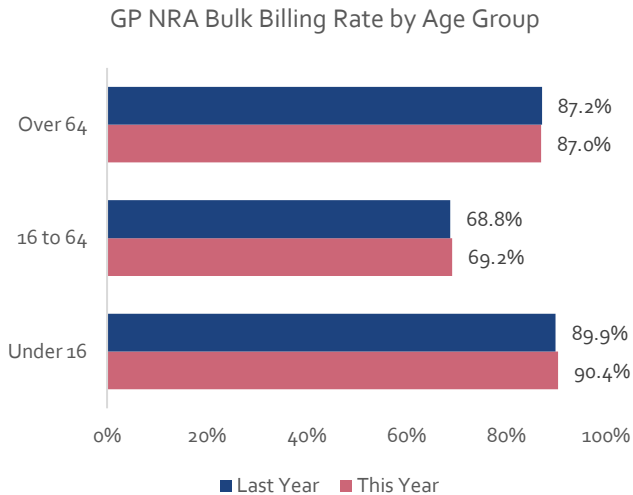
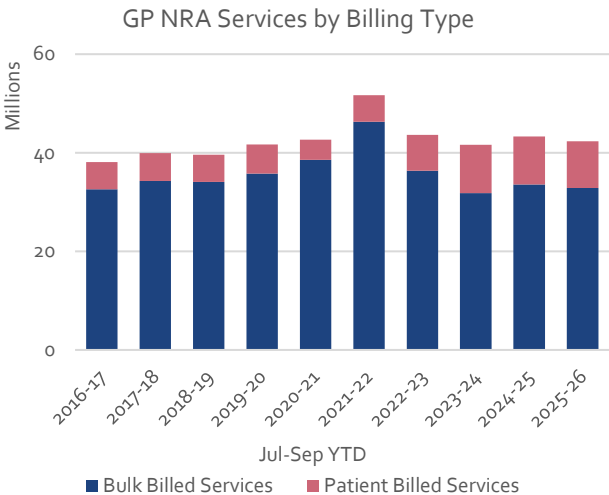
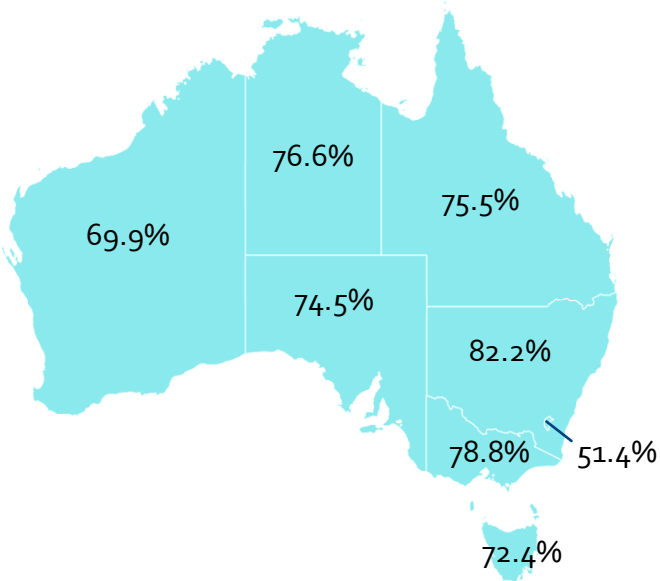

GP NRA services account for 34.5% of Medicare services. In 2025-26 Jul-Sep YTD, there were **42.3m GP NRA services**, down from 43.3m in the same period in the previous year. **GP NRA benefits paid remains stable at \$2.5b.**

Bulk billed services are provided at no cost to the patient. The bulk billing rate is defined as bulk billed services divided by total services.

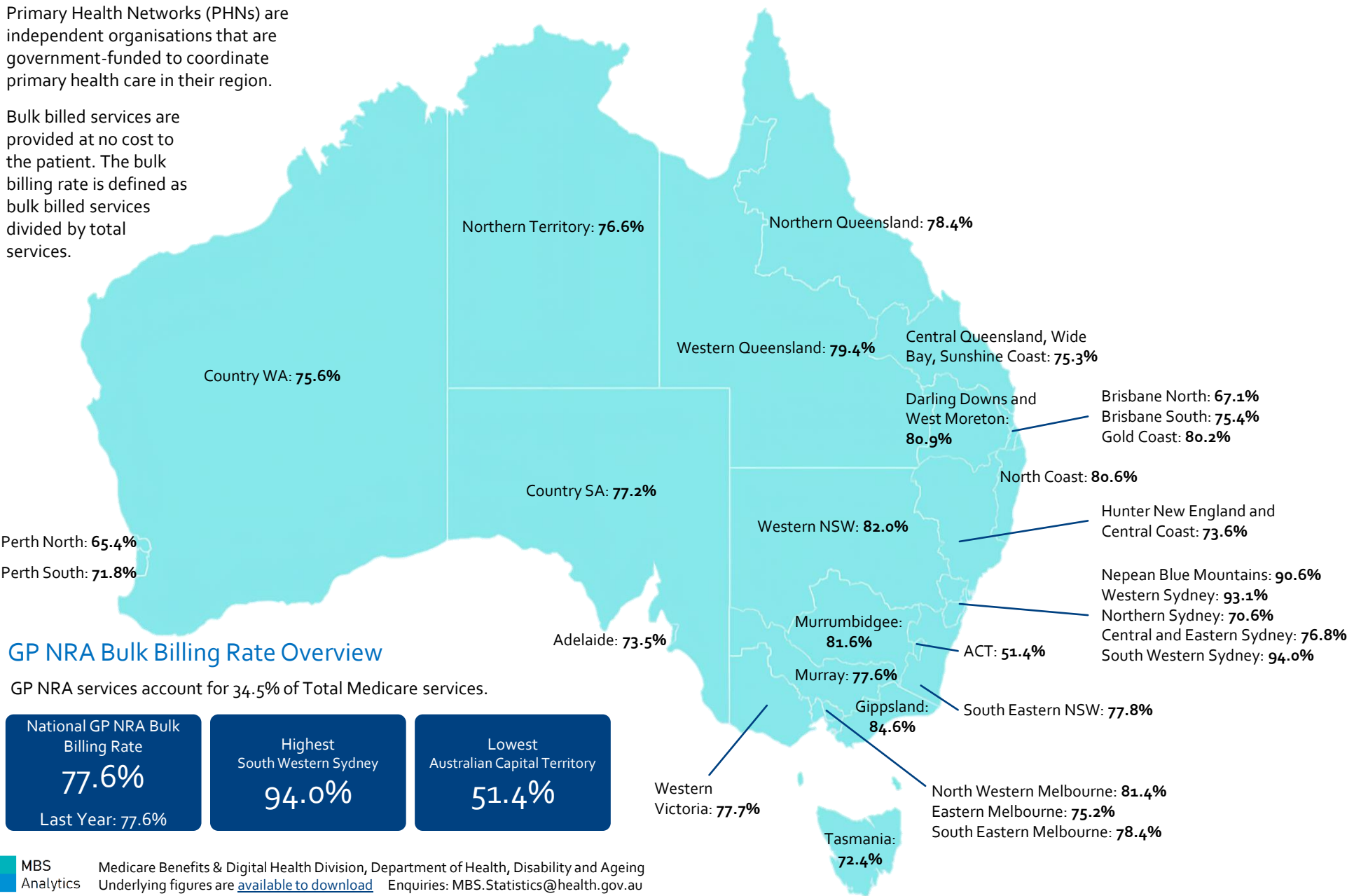
GP NRA Bulk Billing Rate

Primary Health Networks (PHNs) are independent organisations that are government-funded to coordinate primary health care in their region.

Bulk billed services are provided at no cost to the patient. The bulk billing rate is defined as bulk billed services divided by total services.

GP NRA Level B accounts for **67.1%** of all GP NRA services in 2025-26 Jul-Sep YTD.

GP NRA Level A Brief:

- GP attendances for obvious and straight forward cases (Item 3 and equivalents)

GP NRA Level B Standard:

- GP attendances lasting less than 20 or 25 minutes (Item 23 and equivalents)

GP NRA Level C Long:

- GP attendances lasting at least 20 or 25 minutes (Item 36 and equivalents)

GP NRA Level D Prolonged:

- GP attendances lasting at least 40 or 45 minutes (Item 44 and equivalents)

GP NRA Level E Extended:

- GP attendances lasting at least 60 minutes (Item 123 and equivalents)

GP NRA Chronic Disease and Complex Care:

- GP attendances for patients with chronic conditions or complex medical conditions

GP NRA After Hours:

- GP attendances on a public holiday, Sunday and specified periods between Monday and Saturday

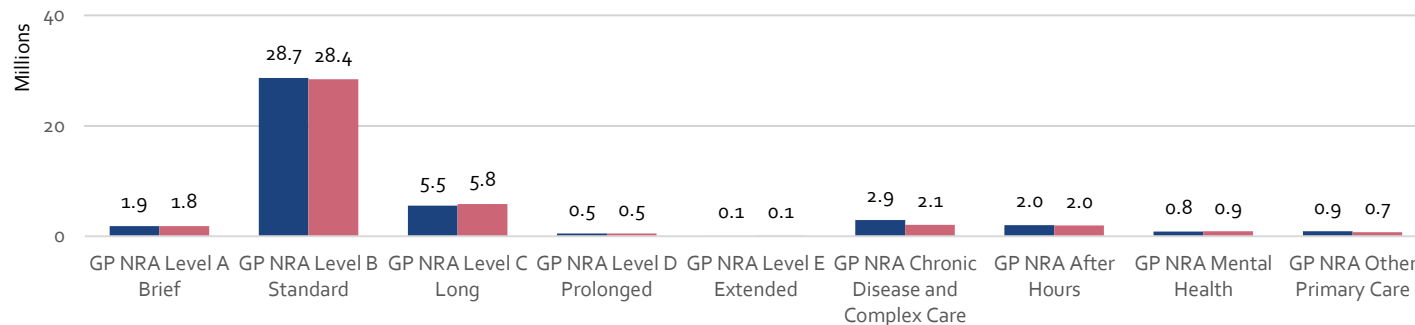
GP NRA Mental Health:

- GP attendances relating to mental health care

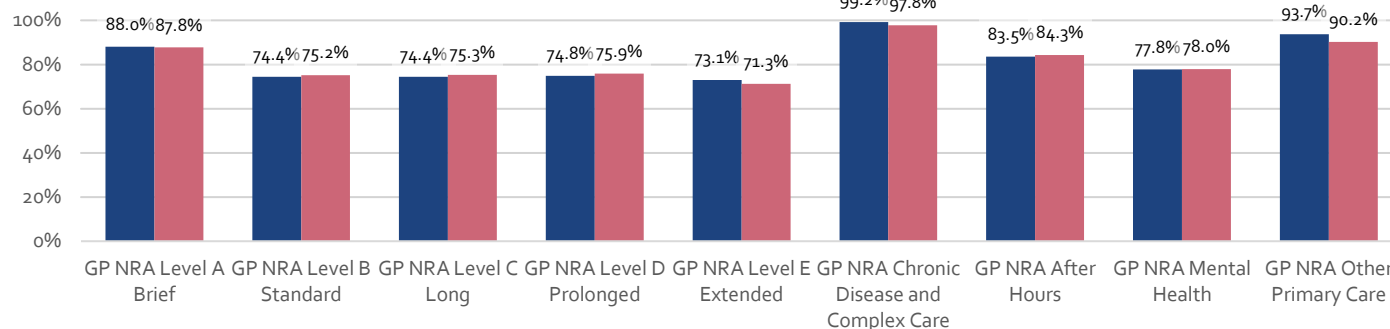
GP NRA Other:

- GP attendances that do not fall within the other GP categories (includes COVID-19 Vaccines)

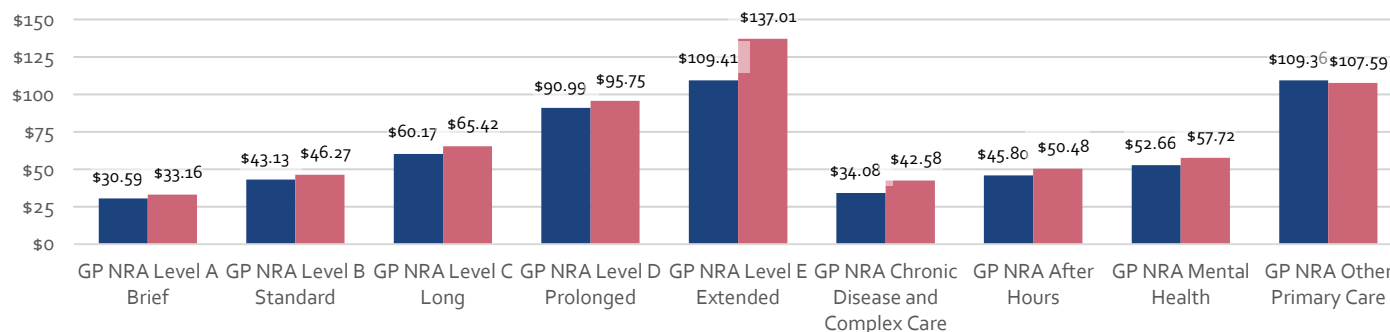
GP NRA Services by Type

GP Non-Referred Attendances (GP NRA) by SEIFA and Age Group, 2025-26 Jul-Sep YTD

In 2025-26 Jul-Sep YTD, the **GP NRA bulk billing rate in the most disadvantaged areas was 88.1%**, 10.5 percentage points higher than the national GP NRA bulk billing rate of 77.6% for the same period last year.

The Socio-Economic Indexes for Areas (SEIFA) are published by the Australian Bureau of Statistics and rank areas in Australia according to socio-economic variables.

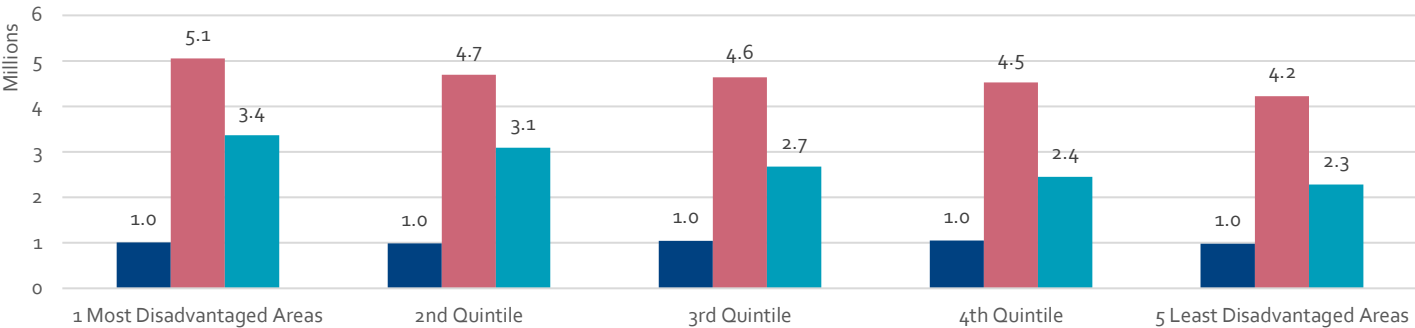
The measures (services, bulk billing rate and average patient contribution) on this page are shown against the Index of Relative Socio-Economic Disadvantage (IRSD).

Areas are more likely to be identified as disadvantaged if there are many:

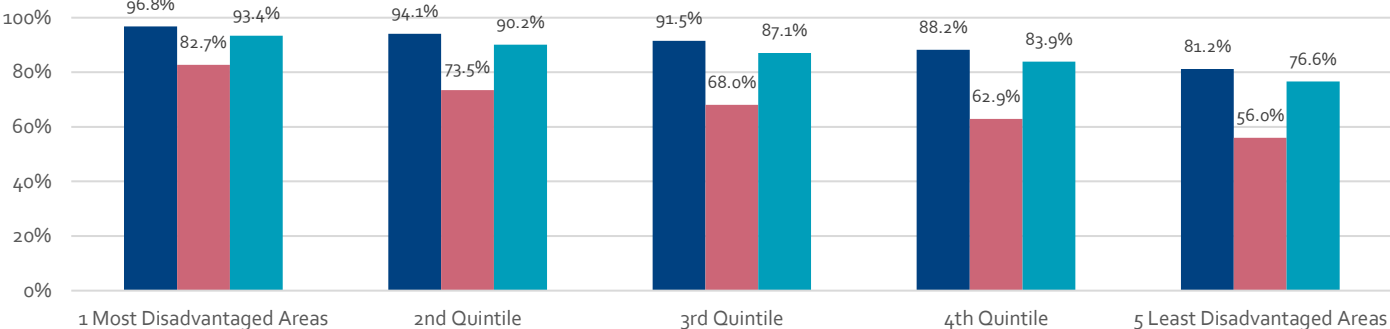
- households with low income,
- people with no qualifications, or
- people in low skill occupations

As SEIFA indexes are assigned to areas, and not individuals, indexes indicate the average socio-economic characteristics of people, families and households living in the area.
