Senior Executive Service employees within the department, acting as delegates of the System Governor, have made arrangements under subsection 582(1) of the *Aged Care Act* 2024 in relation to the following provisions of the Act:

- Subsection 78(1) (which deals with classification levels)
 - The Department notes that classification level decisions are automated for ongoing residential care and ongoing home support using the Australian National Aged Care Classification (AN-ACC) and Integrated Assessment Tool (IAT) classification algorithm respectively. Other classification level decisions are made by the assessor delegate.
- Subsection 86(1) (which deals with priority category decisions)
- Subsection 92(1) (which deals with allocation of places to individuals)
- Subsection 93(1) (which deals with deciding the order of allocation of places to individuals)
- Section 541 (insofar as it deals with star ratings).
