You need to:

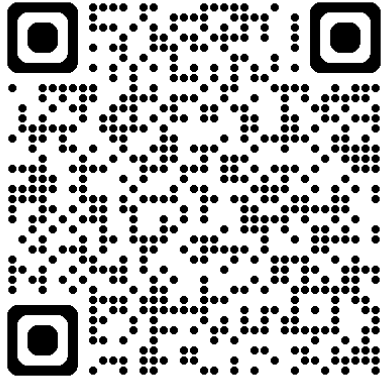
- verify your services and pricing in the My Aged Care Service and Support Portal

You must enter your prices directly into the portal. Uploading or linking to a price schedule on your website does not fulfil your obligations under the new Aged Care Act.

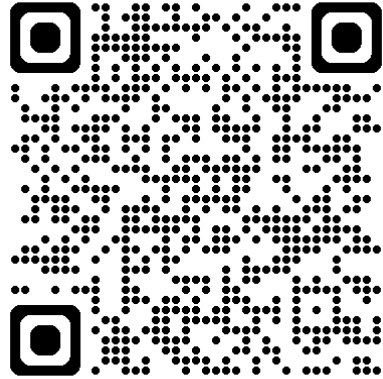

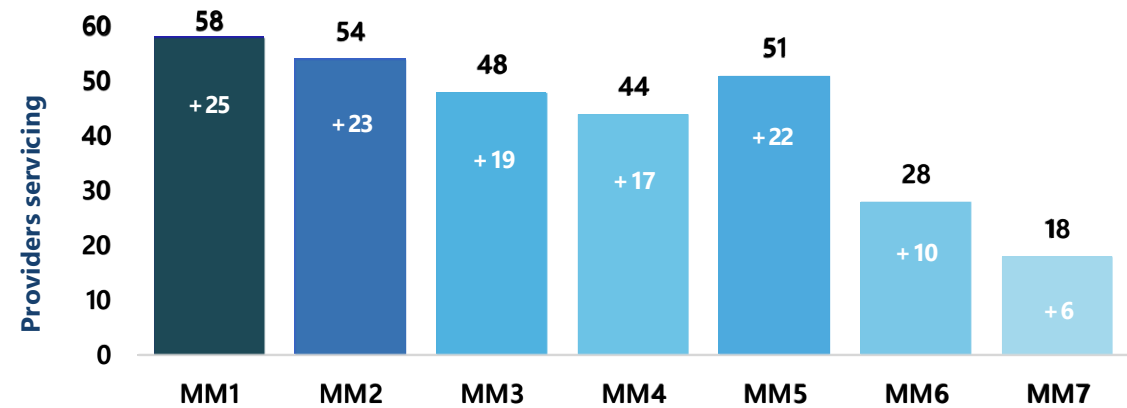
# Expanding our regional representation
