Is the collection authorised or required by law?	The collection of this information is required if the Registered Provider applies for a specialised residential care home status under either section 243-10 or 243-15 of the <i>Aged Care Rules 2025</i> .
Why does the department collect your personal information?	We collect personal information for the purpose of determining a residential care home's eligibility for specialised status.
What would happen if the department did not collect your personal information?	If you do not or are unable to provide your personal information, the Department may not be able to determine whether the residential care home has met the requirements necessary to be a specialised residential care home.
Who will the department disclose your personal information to?	We will not disclose your personal information.
