From 1 January 2026, if you have a Medicare card, you'll pay no more than \$25 for medicines subsidised under the Pharmaceutical Benefits Scheme (PBS), plus any applicable premium.

Commonwealth concession card holders will continue to pay \$7.70 until 2030.

Cheaper medicines will help Australians with the cost of living.
