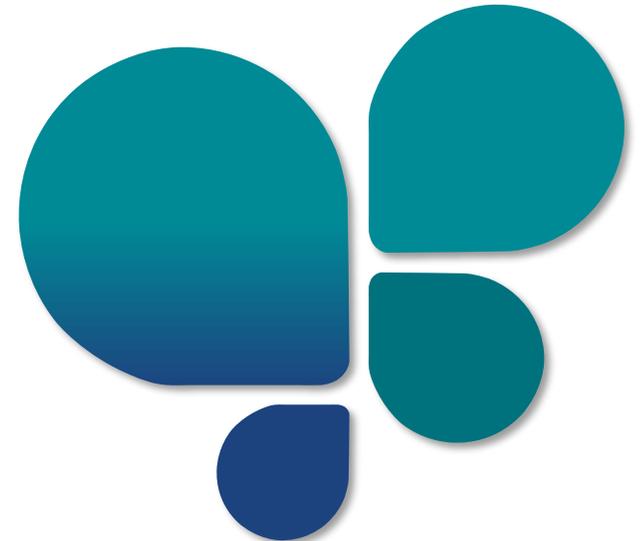

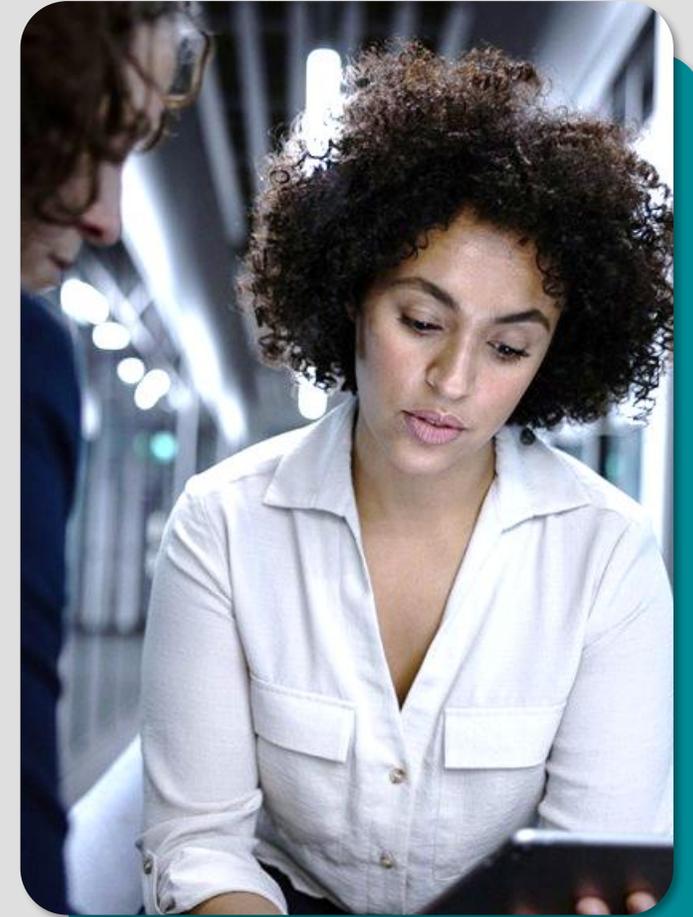


# Support at Home notifications

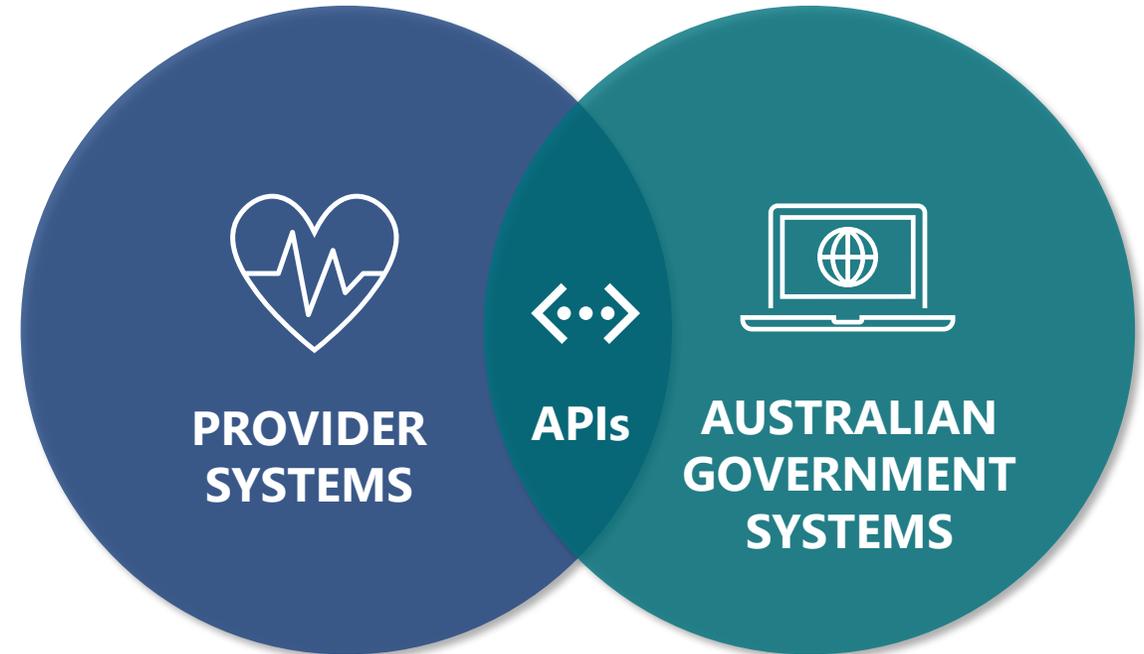

# Building technology connections

B2G is **building technology connections** to improve information and data sharing between Aged Care providers and the Australian Government.

Improved information and data sharing will **help deliver the aged care reforms**.



# The journey



## Research

- Gather feedback from stakeholders on aged care reporting or information areas that need to be streamlined
- Evaluate various API possibilities to address these needs
- Narrow down the list of APIs based on relevance and impact.

## Assessment and consultation

- Assess whether each API can be implemented and aligns with sector goals
- Hold discussions and workshops to refine the API options based on stakeholder input.

## Prioritisation and recommendation

- Prioritise APIs based on their potential benefits and alignment with strategic goals
- Prepare a report recommending which APIs to be implemented first
- Progress recommendations through appropriate approval pathways.

## Implementation

- Co-design and detailed documentation of APIs
- Stakeholder engagement and adoption.

# Client Management API announcement

Use Case: Following referral acceptance, the Client Management APIs enable the direct flow of My Aged Care information into provider systems, minimising manual data entry and supporting faster onboarding.

**Client Management** is the next set of application programming interfaces (APIs)

Client Management APIs provide access to:

- Client Management
- Referral Management
- Support Plans
- Assessments

# Aged Care Data & Reporting Review

An overview

## Project Objectives

- Provide a **consolidated view** of the full scope of information collected from aged care providers (including reporting mechanisms).
- Identify **inconsistencies** or **duplication** of data collection and provision, and interactions between reporting requirements.
- Design a **data ecosystem** that makes high quality data available to support stakeholders across the system.
- Reduce unnecessary **administrative burden** on providers and government through more intelligent data sharing and reporting.
- Develop a roadmap for **data standardisation** and **streamlined** reporting, linked to system design and implementation of known and future reforms, that will see improvements in the scope, quality, consistency and utility of aged care data.



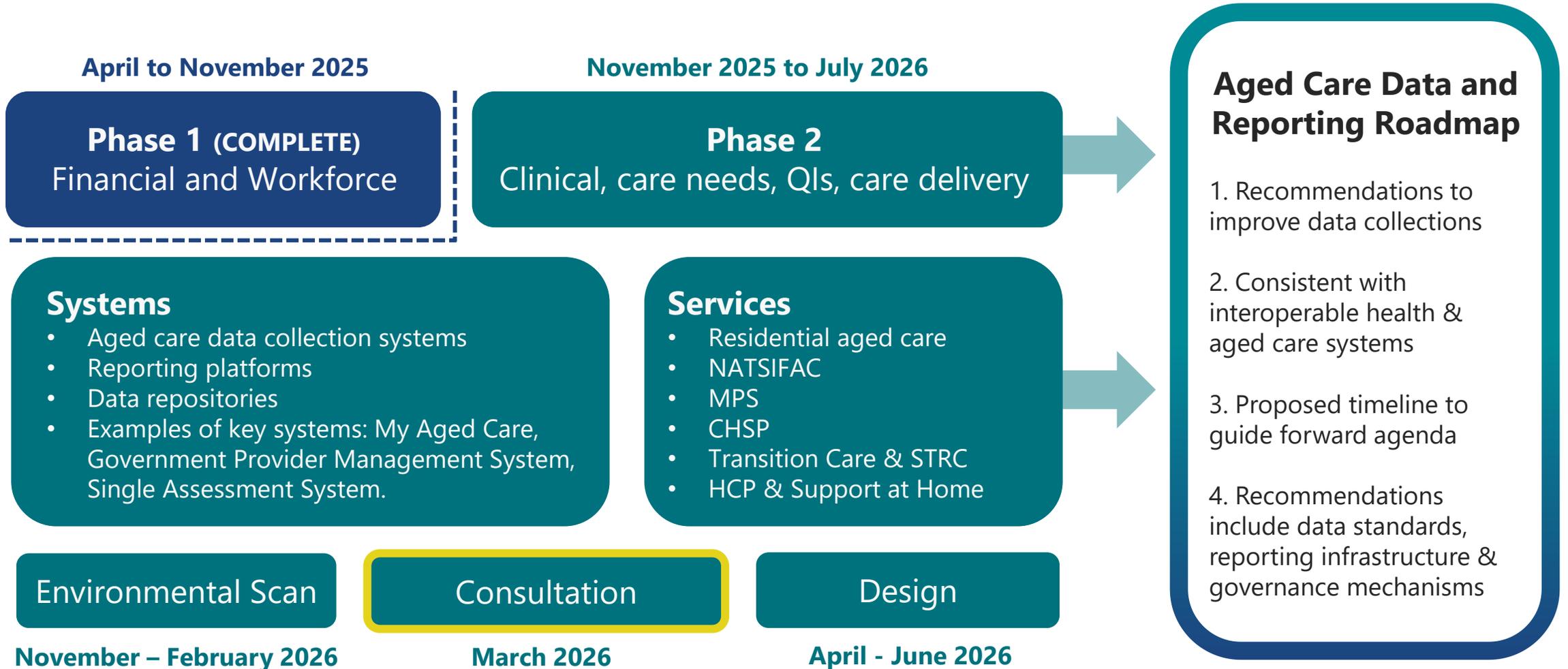

# Aged Care Data & Reporting Review

## What we heard in Phase 1

### Key Themes

- Business systems not interoperable or aligned to reporting requirements
- Manual entry, reconciliation processes & multiple portals are burdensome
- Limited internal value of reported data
- Lack of data standards and inconsistent definitions
- Opportunities for automation and real-time data
- Process and communication challenges

- **Discovery work** has identified opportunities to improve **governance**, consolidate **reporting** and opportunities for **APIs** and **reuse** of data between agencies
- We will now **iterate** on Phase 1 to consider **clinical, care-needs and care-quality** data

*"There's a lot of back-end transformation to try and make sure that the data we extract is appropriate for the request from the Department...the Department's asking for something a bit different from what we normally do."*

# Aged Care Data & Reporting Review

Engagement Request: Clinical, Service & Quality Data

We will release a public consultation paper on **24 February** and will be holding targeted online consultations



- Two forums specifically for aged care software vendors will be held **Tuesday 17 & Wednesday 25 March**.
- Forums for residential & home care providers will be held between **Wednesday 11 & Tuesday 24 March**.
- Recommended attendees include **business analysts** and **health informaticians**.
- Will be advertised in the Your Aged Care Update (YACU) newsletter, **24th February**.

## Consultations will examine

1. Potential granularity of care-quality data
2. Reducing time lags between reported & published data
3. Alignment of reported data with clinical codes and transfer standards
4. Potential for agreed set of data items across aged care
