



## Australian Immunisation Register - Influenza Data - 1 March to 5 April

Notes and Caveats									
- All data is based on influenza vaccinations reported to the Australian Immunisation Register (AIR) as at COB 5 April 2026.									
- Data is from 1 March to 5 April for each encounter year.									
- Influenza vaccination data is not directly comparable across years due to a range of factors, including:									
- The impact of the COVID-19 pandemic and national and local responses to the pandemic over time									
- Early in the influenza season, the timing of seasonal events such as Easter									
- Timing of vaccines provided by pharmaceutical companies for clearance through the Therapeutic Goods Administration (TGA)									
- Supply of vaccines and commencement of flu season.									
- Vaccinations where the person has since been 'End dated' in the Medicare Consumer Directory (due to death, emigration, etc) are included in the data.									
- Data includes influenza vaccinations given to Medicare eligible and non-Medicare eligible individuals.									
- The counted values represent a count of all vaccination episodes.									
- A 'Vaccination episode' is linked to a State or Territory based on the vaccinated individual's Medicare residential address at the time of this report's creation.									
- The sum of state totals may not match the national total due to suppression rules introduced to protect the privacy of individuals
