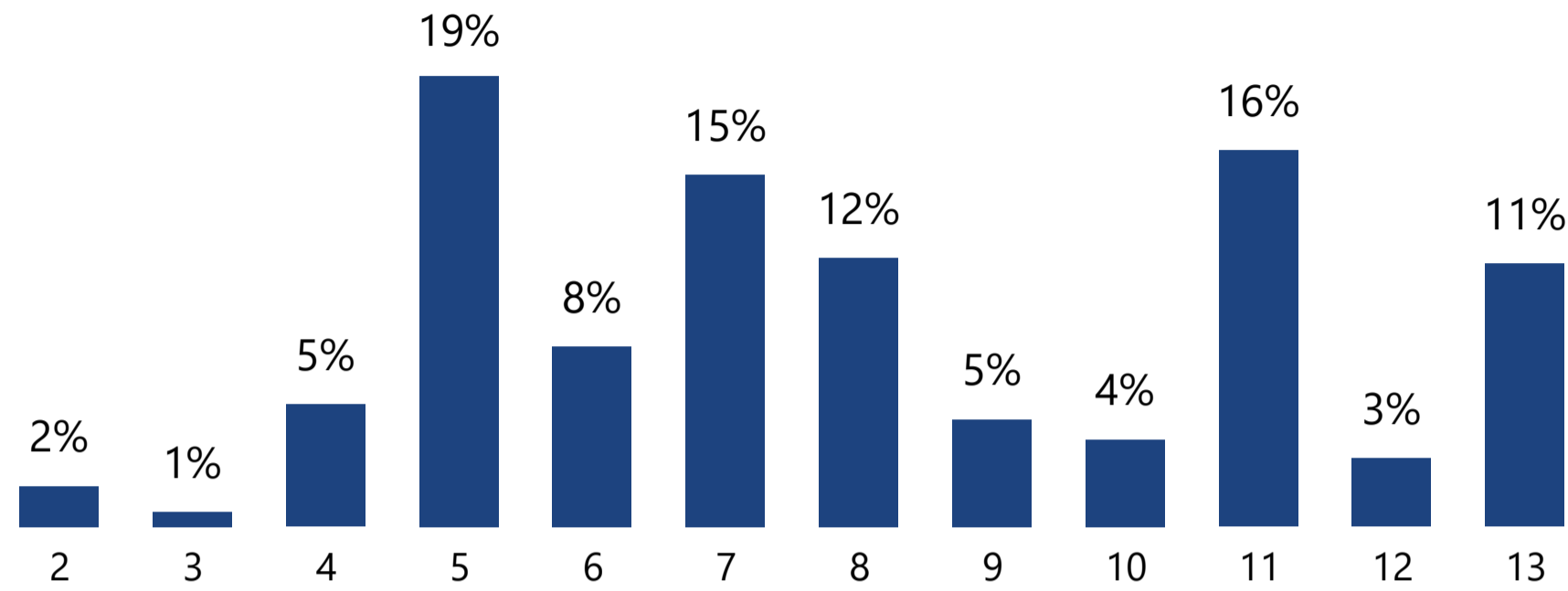

AN-ACC Classification Distribution for Residents In Care



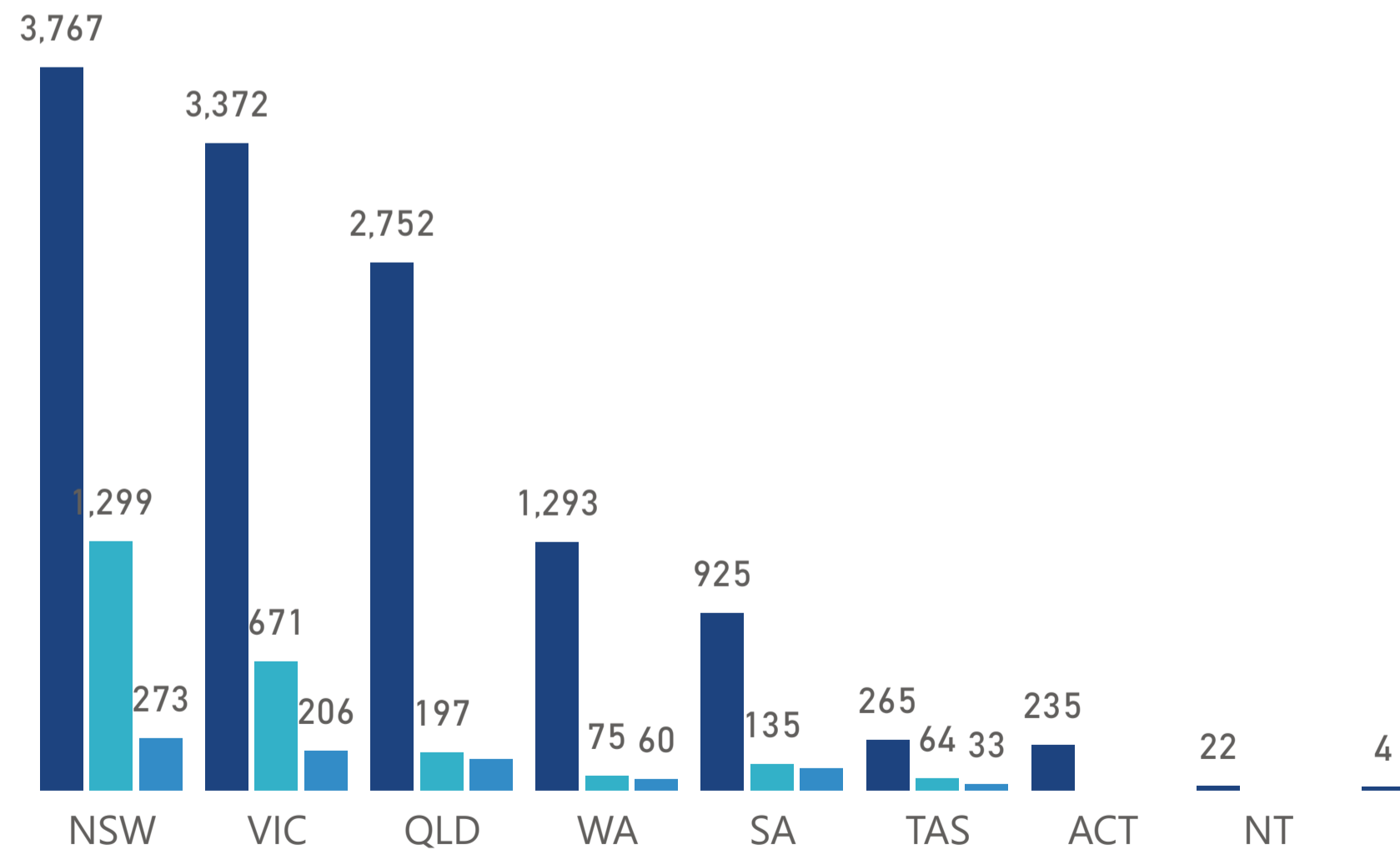

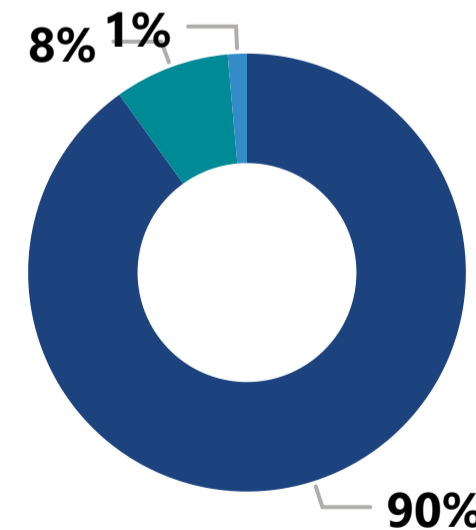

Monthly Highlights

- Compared to the last quarter of 2025, the number of residents requiring assessment fell significantly in Q1 this year.
- Assessment activity remained largely driven by reclassifications, with initial assessments and reconsiderations making up smaller but steady shares.
- Timeliness stayed strong, with around 90% completed within 28 days and very few exceeding KPI timeframes.
