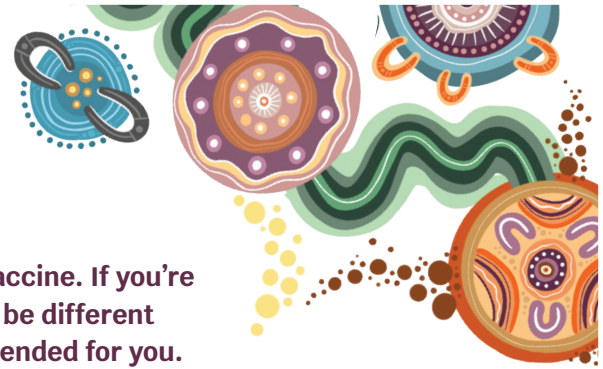


WHO'S ELIGIBLE FOR A FREE VACCINE?



This table explains who's eligible for a free flu, COVID-19 and RSV vaccine. If you're immunocompromised, or have certain medical conditions, it might be different for you. Yarn to your doctor or health worker about what's recommended for you.

Disease	Vaccination Eligibility	Vaccination Timing
Influenza (flu):	All Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people aged 6 months or older	Every 12 months
COVID-19:	All people aged 65 - 74 years All people aged 75 years and over	Every 12 months Every 6 months
Respiratory Syncytial Virus (RSV)*:	Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people aged 60 years and over	One dose
