Accepting your Bonded Offer

To be eligible, you must be:

- an Australian citizen or Permanent Visa holder that resides in Australia, and
- accepted into a course of study in medicine at an Australian university.

If you accept a Bonded CSP in a course of study in medicine at an Australian university, you must:

- agree to participate in the Program by 30 June in your first year of study to maintain your enrolment in your medical course
- comply with the Program conditions outlined at 124ZG of the *Health Insurance Act 1973*.

You should seek legal advice to make sure you understand your obligations before accepting a Bonded CSP at university.

Once your university's Bonded CSP offer has been confirmed, you will receive an email titled - **'BONDED MEDICAL PROGRAM – Agree to Participate'** which will contain your BRoSS Username and Temporary password to log in. If you do not receive this email, please contact your university or email the bondedmedicalprogram@health.gov.au.

To register your agreement, you will need to use BRoSS. Please refer to the [BRoSS Participant User Guide – How to login](#) about how to log in to BRoSS for the first time. You will need to have a myGov account to log in to BRoSS. Go to [MyGov Home](#).

The Bonded Medical Program

In this Section In this section you can agree to participate in the Bonded Medical Program (Program). We strongly encourage you to seek legal advice before agreeing to participate to ensure you understand your obligations.

The Program is a statutory scheme which provides a Commonwealth Supported Place (CSP) in a medical course at an Australian university as a benefit to students. In exchange, participants commit to completing work in regional, rural or remote areas or areas of workforce shortage for 156 weeks. This is called a Return of Service Obligation (RoSO).

If you choose not to participate, please inform your university that you will not become a Program participant.

Agreement to participate

You become a Program participant when you agree to participate in the Program.

Participants of the Bonded Medical Program are bound by [Part VD of the Health Insurance Act 1973 \(Act\)](#) and must abide by the [Health Insurance \(Bonded Medical Program\) Rule 2020 \(Rule\)](#). You must ensure you understand your obligations as outlined in these documents before you agree to participate in the Program.

You will remain a Program participant until an event mentioned in subsection 124ZE(4) of The [Act](#) applies to you.
