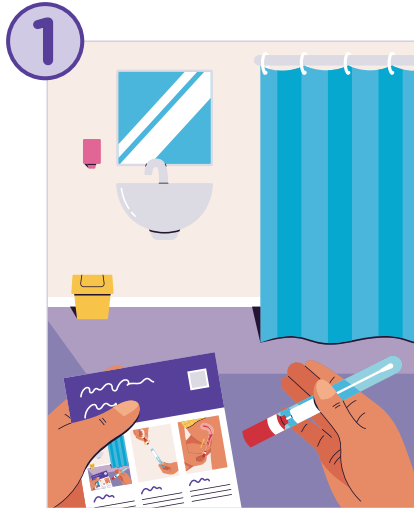
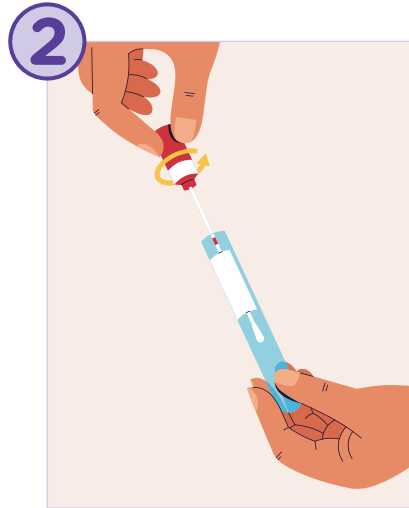


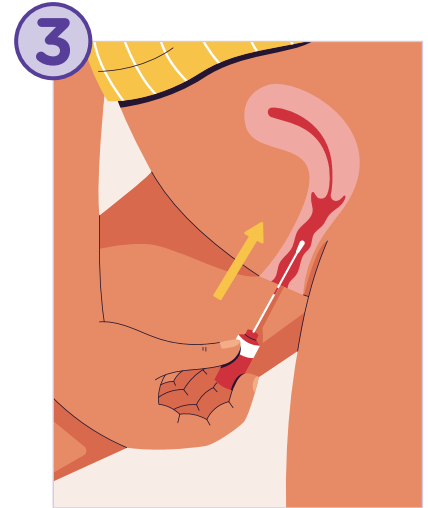
How to do your own Cervical Screening Test



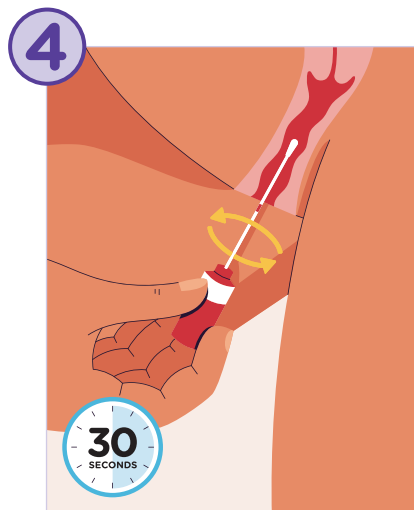
1 You will be provided with a private space to collect your sample.



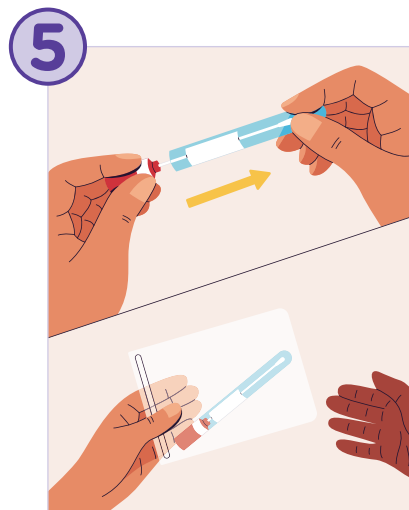
2 Twist the cap and remove the swab from the tube. Hold on to the cap and do not touch the end of the swab.



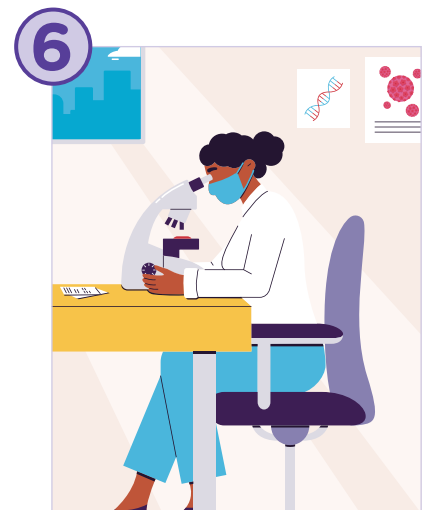
3 Insert the swab into your vagina. You do not need to reach your cervix. The swab should have a red mark to show you how far to put it in.



4 Gently move the swab in a circle inside your vagina. Do this for 20-30 seconds to collect a sample.



5 Gently remove the swab from your vagina/front hole. Place the swab back into the tube, screw the cap back on and give it back to your healthcare provider.



6 Your healthcare provider will send your sample to a pathology laboratory to be tested. Your healthcare provider will let you know your results.
