

# Project Synergy Monthly Report

Report at 30 November 2018

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### Lived Experience (LE)

The November meeting Working Group was held over 2 days (27 and 28th November). Agenda items included: finalising the selection panel process for Panel EOI, reviewing Education and Training strategy from LE perspective, reviewing Open Arms trial engagement activity, establishing a collaborative agreement with the Communications Manager to add value to the social media and communications strategy, giving final inputs into the NCC program draft, and refining the product development model in order to meet the requirements of Phase II of Project Synergy, taking into consideration the lessons learned over Phase I.

The LEAF Working Group focused on the lived experience engagement activities over November. As per actions from the October meeting:

- The Working Group planned and executed the s 47G engagement activity;
- Participated in a digital and social media channels engagement activity;
- Continued to finalise the National Community Consultation program draft;
- An EOI was put out to recruit additional members to the panel and increase diversity. Applications close 6 November; and
- Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander representatives s 47F met with Research leads to give advice and guidance regarding trial engagement. This lead to a proposed Aboriginal and

Torres Strait Islander People specific trial being currently scoped with their leadership. They also met with InnoWell management to discuss cultural diversity needs within the organisation.

During November, the broader Panel was given an opportunity to engage in the following:

- Feedback on the Platform showcase, live and by replay;
- Asked to widely disseminate the Panel EoI to their networks;
- Express their interest in participating in future Summary dashboard user testing;
- Contribute to upcoming events to go into the NCC timeline draft; and
- Invitation to all LEAF members to be welcome to visit the office if in the area.
