

FOI request 1440:

I request details of the deaths of persons in the national prioritisation system in 17-18 and 18-19.

Fiona Buffington's statement of 11 March 2019 to the Royal Commission into Aged Care Quality and Safety Commission said (p24)

"During the 12 month period of 1 July 2017 to 30 June 2018, a total of 212,857 people appeared in the national prioritisation system for at least part of the year. Of these people, 16,076 were taken of the list when they passed."

Could I please have the split between levels of approved care for these 16,076?

Similarly, could I please have the number dying while on the list in 18-19, and the split between levels?

Response:

The following table provides a breakdown of the 16,076 and 11,987 people who had exited the Home Care National Prioritisation System (NPS) in 2017-18 and 2018-19 respectively with the reason of 'deceased' entered in My Aged Care as per your request in the FOI.
