The proposed project will address three of the four key areas of the CHHP program</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Drug and alcohol treatment</li> <li>• Preventative, primary and chronic disease management; and</li> <li>• Mental Health</li> </ul> <p>It will meet the objectives of the program through</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Reducing pressure on community and hospital services; and</li> <li>• Supporting long-term reform by improving people’s access to essential health services, improving health outcome and preventing disease.</li> </ul> <p>Project funding will be used to upgrade facilities at Beenleigh to deliver increased access to specialist healthcare. It will also be used for a targeted education and awareness campaign.</p> <p><b>Identified risks and mitigation:</b></p> <p>PRS opened on 4 June 2018. There is little information available about their history and there is no annual report or audited financial statements available. Following a search of GPS/FOFMS and the internet it appears that PRS has not received Commonwealth funding previously. When negotiating the funding agreement the Commonwealth Grant officer should ensure that expectations, particularly around reporting (performance and financial) are made clear and that assistance is available throughout the development and implementation of the project.</p>		

**Grant agreement inclusions:** The funding agreement will be with an 'Other Partnership' entity (a partnership between 2 separate Trustees of Trusts). Advice should be sought to ensure that the department uses correct templates etc.
