 - Qantas flight from Wuhan successfully arrived in Darwin this morning.
 - No passengers are showing signs of being unwell; following biosecurity checks, 0 passengers will be transferred by bus to the Howard Springs facility.
 - A small number of Pacific Island nationals were also aboard the flight.
- Christmas Island update:
 - One person s47F tested for nCoV - awaiting results 24-48 hrs - UPDATE: results were returned negative for nCoV.

 - ACTION: Rhonda to liaise with the AUSMAT Team Lead in relation to Dr Young continuina her stav.
- Overall there is a significant growth of nCoV in Hubei province; smaller elsewhere in mainland China.
