Explanation of requirement for an AFM:

This Advance is required in order to address the unforeseen scale of the COVID-19 spread across the globe and possible shortages in masks and other personal protective equipment (PPE), test materials and other medical supplies, and ventilators and other medical equipment, due to global demand and domestic manufacturing capability.

Urgent:

It is critical that the Commonwealth procure masks and other emergency medical equipment or emergency health equipment and supplies urgently, as it is unlikely stock will be available in the necessary quantity for an extended period.
