Product: Coloplast Brava Protective Seal **Applicant:** Coloplast Pty Ltd **Date of SPAP Meeting:** 22 October 2019

1. Proposed Variation on the Stoma Appliance Scheme

The applicant, Coloplast Pty Ltd, sought the addition of two variants to the current listing of the Coloplast Brava Protective Seal (SAS Code 80127F) in subgroup 9(l) of the Stoma Appliance Scheme (SAS) Schedule. The product, including ten variants, is currently listed at a unit price of \$4.532, with a maximum monthly quantity of 30 units.

2. Variants to be added

The applicant requested the following variants be added to the existing listing for SAS Code 80127F.

3. Background

This product was first listed on the SAS Schedule in December 2016.

4. Clinical Place for the Product

The proposed product provides an alternative for users requiring a product to improve the seal around the stoma, protecting peristomal skin from corrosive output.

Financial Analysis

Listing of two variants is recommended on a cost-minimisation basis compared to products currently listed in subgroup 9(l) of the SAS Schedule. It is therefore unlikely that there would be any budgetary impact for the SAS as a consequence of listing two variants to the current product range.

5. SPAP Recommendation

The SPAP recommended the addition of two variants to the current product range for Coloplast Brava Protective Seal (SAS Code 80127F) listed in subgroup 9(1), of the SAS Schedule at the unit price of \$4.532, with a maximum monthly quantity of 30 units.

6. Context for Decision

The SPAP helps decide whether stoma products should be subsidised and, if so, the conditions of their subsidisation in Australia. It considers submissions in this context. An SPAP decision not to recommend listing or changes to a listing does not represent a final SPAP view about the merits of a particular stoma product. A company can resubmit to the SPAP following a decision not to recommend listing or changes to a listing. The SPAP is an advisory committee and as such its recommendations are non-binding on Government. All SPAP recommendations are subject to Cabinet/Ministerial approval.

7. Applicant's Comment

Coloplast Pty Ltd agrees with the SPAP's recommendation.
