1. Proposed Listing on the Stoma Appliance Scheme

The applicant, Hollister, sought the addition of a price premium, for the Ceramide Skin Barrier, to the following Moderma Flex CeraPlus and New Image CeraPlus products currently listed on the SAS Schedule:

3. Background

This was the Stoma Product Assessment Panel's (SPAP) fourth consideration of these products.

4. Clinical Place for the Product

The proposed products provide an alternative for users in each subgroup.

5. SPAP Comment

Clinical Analysis

The Panel noted the applicant had supplied additional clinical studies in support of the applications, however, the Panel agreed this information did not provide sufficient evidence to support a Price Premium over the benchmark price.

The Panel also agreed the products that are currently listed should be retained on the SAS Schedule at the current benchmark price.

Economic Analysis

The Panel noted the applicant provided an economic analysis in support of the applications. However, the method used in the economic analysis is unclear.

6. SPAP Recommendation

The SPAP recommended the applications for the addition of a price premium to the existing Moderma Flex CeraPlus and New Image CeraPlus products as listed below be rejected due to inadequate evidence to support superiority.

7. Context for Decision

The SPAP helps decide whether stoma products should be subsidised and, if so, the conditions of their subsidisation in Australia. It considers submissions in this context. An SPAP decision not to recommend listing or changes to a listing does not represent a final SPAP view about the merits of a particular stoma product. A company can resubmit to the SPAP following a decision not to recommend listing or changes to a listing. The SPAP is an advisory committee and as such its recommendations are non-binding on Government. All SPAP recommendations are subject to Cabinet/Ministerial approval.

8. Applicant's Comment

Hollister accepts the SPAP's recommendation at this time.
