A Grant Agreement can only be varied by written agreement between Your Organisation and the Department.

The Funding specified for an Activity in a Grant Agreement that is paid to Your Organisation must only be used by Your Organisation for the purpose of performing the Activity.

The provision of Funding is subject to Your Organisation's ongoing compliance with the Grant Agreement.

An executed grant agreement between Your Organisation and the Department does not imply any commitment to further funding.

Your Organisation is provided with the Agreement which must be signed.

If your Organisation agrees to deliver the Activities outlined in the Agreement, please print, sign and date. Please then scan and email the signed copy to s22

When the Department has executed the Agreement, it will return one executed copy of the Agreement to Your Organisation for Your Organisation's records.

A grant agreement starts on the Commencement Date and ends on the Completion Date, those dates being defined in the Terms and Conditions for the Standard Grant Agreement.

If Your Organisation believes that it will have difficulty complying with any part of the grant agreement, it will need to resolve those difficulties before signing the Agreement. If Your Organisation is uncertain about any aspects of the funding agreement it should seek independent legal advice before signing the Grant Agreement.
