Getting tested for breast cancer can save your life.

So by having a free BreastScreen test every two years, you can make sure any problems are found, even before you can feel them.

You can take a friend or family member if it makes you feel more comfortable. A female worker will help you, and she'll make sure you feel relaxed and safe. The breast screen is done in private, and only takes a few minutes. It's free for women aged **50 to 74**. If you're over 75, talk to your GP or health professional to find out if breast screening is right for you.
