

## PUBLIC SUMMARY DOCUMENT

**Product:** Hollister Moderma Flex

**Applicant:** Hollister

**Date of Meeting:** 20 October 2020

### 1. Proposed Variation on the Stoma Appliance Scheme

The applicant, Hollister, sought a variation to Hollister Moderma Flex (SAS Code 5676R) in subgroup 11(a), of the Stoma Appliance Scheme (the Scheme) Schedule, due to an upgrade to the tap. The product is currently listed at a unit price of \$16.206, with a maximum monthly quantity of 20 units.

### 2. Variants to be added

The applicant requested an upgrade to the existing product for SAS Code 5676R.

### 3. Background

This product was first listed on the SAS Schedule in November 2011.

### 4. Clinical Place for the Product

The upgrade to the tap provides users with an improved version of the product.

### *Financial Analysis*

The new version of the product is listed at the same price and the same maximum monthly quantity. It is therefore, unlikely that there would be any budgetary impact for the SAS as a consequence of the variant to the product.

### 5. SPAP Recommendation

The Panel recommended the upgrade to the product for Hollister Moderma Flex (SAS Code 5676R) listed in subgroup 11(a), of the SAS Schedule at the unit price of \$16.206, with a maximum monthly quantity of 20 units.

### 6. Context for Decision

The Panel helps decide whether stoma products should be subsidised and, if so, the conditions of their subsidisation in Australia. It considers submissions in this context. A Panel decision not to recommend listing or changes to a listing does not represent a final Panel view about the merits of a particular stoma product. A company can resubmit to the Panel following a decision not to recommend listing or changes to a listing. The Panel is an advisory committee and as such its recommendations are non-binding on Government. All Panel recommendations are subject to Cabinet/Ministerial approval.

### 7. Applicant's Comment

Hollister accepts the outcome as noted above by SPAP.
