Subject: Million Minds - Poll outcomes and next steps [SEC=OFFICIAL]

Dear members,

Thank you for voting in the poll to decide our approach for making recommendations and managing conflicts of interest in finalising the first Million Minds Mission grant round. We have received the final results, and the preferred approach is to allocate the '\$5 million plus one' to each priority area, then allocate the remainder based upon peer review rank. Following tomorrow's NHMRC peer review panel meeting, this approach will be used to make recommendations to the Minister.

In light of these changes, we have decided to cancel the 11 April 2019 meeting. It is proposed that the panel will next meet again in person in June for a future focused workshop, with a teleconference being held between now and then to determine the final arrangements for the workshop. We will be in touch shortly to identify a suitable date.
