

How people with disability in a group residential setting can get a COVID-19 vaccination



If I am an eligible person with disability in a group residential setting and:



I am under 60 years old, I can:



- go to a Pfizer Commonwealth vaccination clinic, or



- go to a state or territory run Pfizer vaccination clinic, or



- get a Pfizer vaccination at my residence.



I am 60 years old or over, I can:



- go to a GP and get an AstraZeneca vaccination, or



- get an AstraZeneca vaccination by a GP at my residence, or



- go to an AstraZeneca vaccination clinic.
