YOUR 2ND DOSE OF PFIZER COVID-19 VACCINATION IS DUE IN 3 WEEKS.

We will send you an SMS reminding you to book an appointment close to the 3rd week after your first vaccine appointment.

PLEASE NOTE THAT THERE SHOULD BE AT LEAST 7 DAYS INTERVAL (BEFORE AND AFTER) BETWEEN COVID-19 VACCINE AND ALL OTHER VACCINES.

Common side effects include fever, chills, tiredness, pain, redness and swelling at site of injection, and sore muscles and joints. These side effects are usually mild and go away within one or two days.

YOU MIGHT WANT TO CHECK YOUR ELIGIBILITY FOR OTHER GOVERNMENT FUNDED IMMUNISATIONS

- Flu Vaccine (Adults 65 and above and younger adults with medical conditions which increased risk of influenza)
- Pneumococcal Vaccine (Adults 70 and above)
- Herpes Zoster (Shingles) Vaccine (Adults 70-79 years of age)
