Background: Since *Williams v Commonwealth (2012) 248 CLR 156* (Williams No.1), Commonwealth spending activities, other than those relating to the ordinary and well-recognised functions of government, require legislative authority to authorise contracting and spending.

Many current spending activities for the Health portfolio are covered by Schedule 1AA of the Regulations. Government made a decision not to add further items to Schedule 1AA but to use Schedule 1AB of the Regulations for new and significantly changed spending activities, where primary legislation is not appropriate to establish authority for the spending activity.



Relevance to Election Commitments / Budget Measures:

Funding of \$1.275 million over two years (2019-20 to 2020-21) will be provided through the \$1.25 billion CHHP announced in the Mid-Year Economic and Fiscal Outlook 2018-19 under 'Ensuring access to quality and affordable health care'. The Program was also announced in the 2019-20
