Product: Smith & Nephew SECURA

1. Proposed Variation on the Stoma Appliance Scheme

The applicant, Smith & Nephew, sought a variation to Smith & Nephew SECURA (SAS Code 9983K) in subgroup 9(d), of the Stoma Appliance Scheme (the Scheme) Schedule, due to a change in company code. The product is currently listed at a unit price of \$8.35, with a maximum monthly quantity of one unit.

2. Variants to be added

The applicant advised of a company code change to the existing product for SAS Code 9983K.

3. Background

This product was first listed on the SAS Schedule in 1 April 2011.

4. Clinical Place for the Product

Not Applicable.

Financial Analysis

The variation is a change in the company code to the currently listed product. It is therefore unlikely that there would be any budgetary impact for the SAS as a consequence of the change in company code.

5. SPAP Recommendation

The Panel recommended the company code change to the product Smith & Nephew SECURA (SAS Code 9983K) listed in subgroup 9(d), of the SAS Schedule at the unit price of \$8.35, with a maximum monthly quantity of one unit.

6. Context for Decision

The Panel helps decide whether stoma products should be subsidised and, if so, the conditions of their subsidisation in Australia. It considers submissions in this context. A Panel decision not to recommend listing or changes to a listing does not represent a final Panel view about the merits of a particular stoma product. A company can resubmit to the Panel following a decision not to recommend listing or changes to a listing. The Panel is an advisory committee and as such its recommendations are non-binding on Government. All Panel recommendations are subject to Cabinet/Ministerial approval.

7. Applicant's Comment

Smith & Nephew agree to the SPAP's recommendation.
