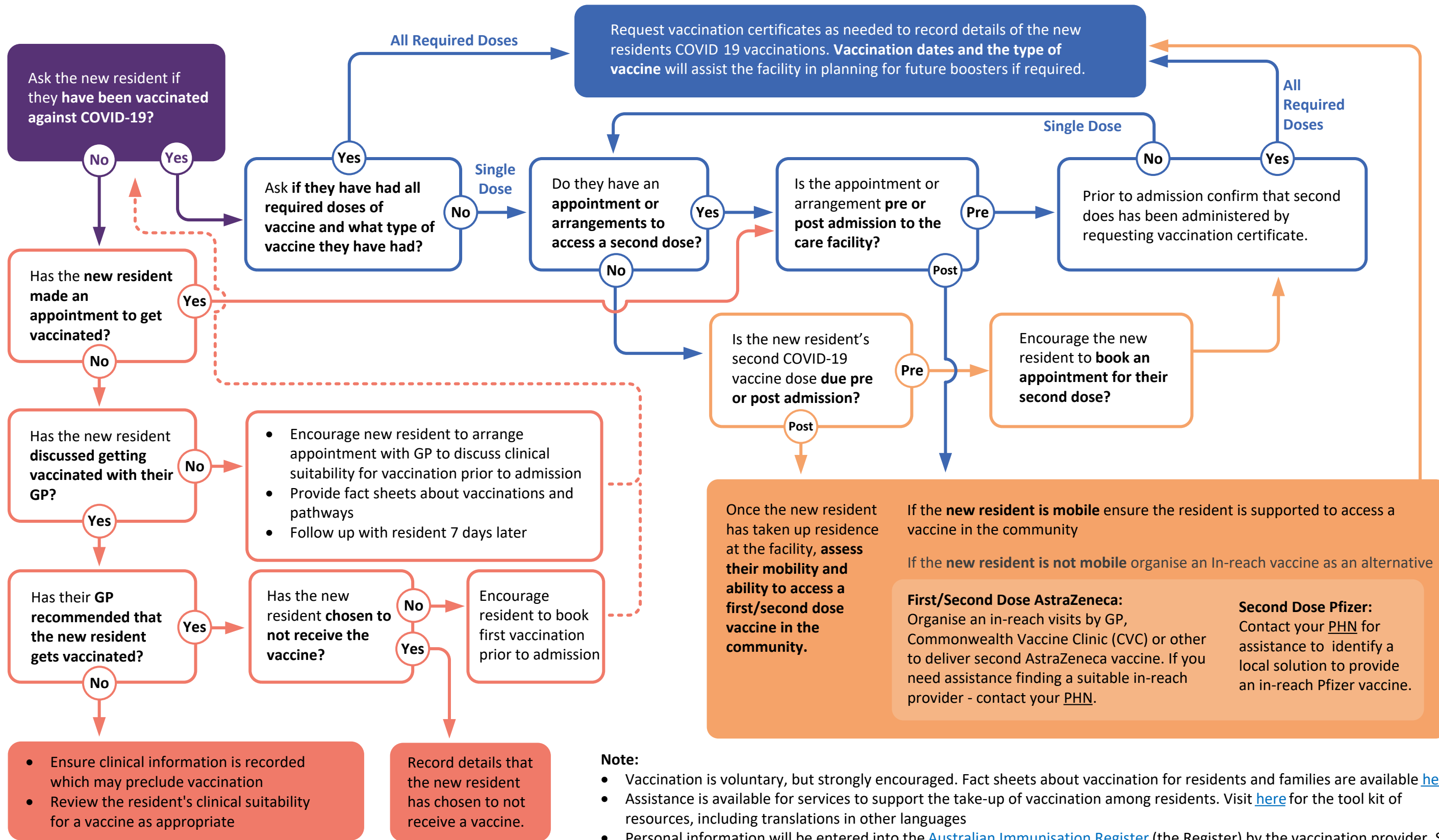


New Resident Entrance Protocol

COVID-19 vaccine program for aged care



Once the new resident has taken up residence at the facility, **assess their mobility and ability to access a first/second dose vaccine in the community.**

If the **new resident is mobile** ensure the resident is supported to access a vaccine in the community

If the **new resident is not mobile** organise an In-reach vaccine as an alternative

First/Second Dose AstraZeneca: Organise an in-reach visits by GP, Commonwealth Vaccine Clinic (CVC) or other to deliver second AstraZeneca vaccine. If you need assistance finding a suitable in-reach provider - contact your PHN.

Second Dose Pfizer: Contact your PHN for assistance to identify a local solution to provide an in-reach Pfizer vaccine.
