Eligibility Checker updates

The national Vaccine Clinic Finder is a single portal where people can access all COVID-19 vaccination clinics across Australia. It continues to be the only way to compare clinic types, check availability, and find and book an appointment in one place. The Vaccine Clinic Finder is easily accessed via the COVID-19 Vaccine Eligibility Checker.

The Vaccine Clinic Finder provides:

- details of over 10,000 vaccination clinics serviced by more than 20 booking providers - individuals can obtain an up to date view of vaccination services provided by general practice, state and territory, Commonwealth Vaccination Centres, pharmacies, Aboriginal Community Controlled Health Organisations, and other healthcare providers.
- A view of available clinics aligned with the individual's requirements by providing
 information in the Vaccine Eligibility Checker that feeds into the Vaccine Clinic Finder
 about age, location and Medicare, users receive a list of clinics tailored to their
 requirements. This reduces the risk of being turned away at point of vaccination.

• Information on how to book an appointment at individual clinics - where digital bookings are available, a link to the booking system is provided. Where a clinic only takes telephone bookings, the phone number is displayed.

The Vaccine Eligibility Checker is a simple filtering tool to help people find the best clinic for them within the Vaccine Clinic Finder.

It's important in our external communications that we refer people to **Australia.gov.au** to click 'find a clinic'.

This is the strength of the fully integrated Vaccine Clinic Finder.

ATAGI Statement 27 August 2021 – 12 to 15 year age group

ATAGI has reviewed the evidence and now supports COVID-19 vaccination in all adolescents from 12 years of age.

Vaccination against COVID-19 is recommended for all people from 12 years of age, extending the current recommendation for those 16 years and older.

A two dose schedule using **Comirnaty (Pfizer)**, the only vaccine currently registered for use in Australia in this age group, is recommended.

ATAGI notes that supply of Comirnaty (Pfizer), and Spikevax (Moderna), if recommended in this age group, remains constrained and so the timing of inclusion of adolescents in the national COVID-19 vaccination program needs to be balanced against access to vaccine in other populations.

On 27 August 2021 National Cabinet confirmed that the rollout to the 12-15 year age group will commence from 13 September 2021.

Vaccination requirements for authorised workers – NSW health orders

In order to work outside their area of concern, authorised workers in NSW must now have received at least one dose of a COVID-19 vaccine by Monday 6 September.

Authorised workers under the age of 16 years will be exempt from the requirement to be vaccinated.


A relevant care worker 16 years and over whose place of residence or place of work is in an area of concern must also have received at least one dose of a COVID-19 vaccine by Monday 6 September in order to attend work. This includes those who work in an early education and care facility or who provide disability support services.

Vaccination is highly encouraged and workers from the LGAs of concern are offered priority bookings for vaccination. In line with the amended public health order, if an authorised worker is not vaccinated or does not have a medical contraindication form, they will not be able to work outside their LGA.
