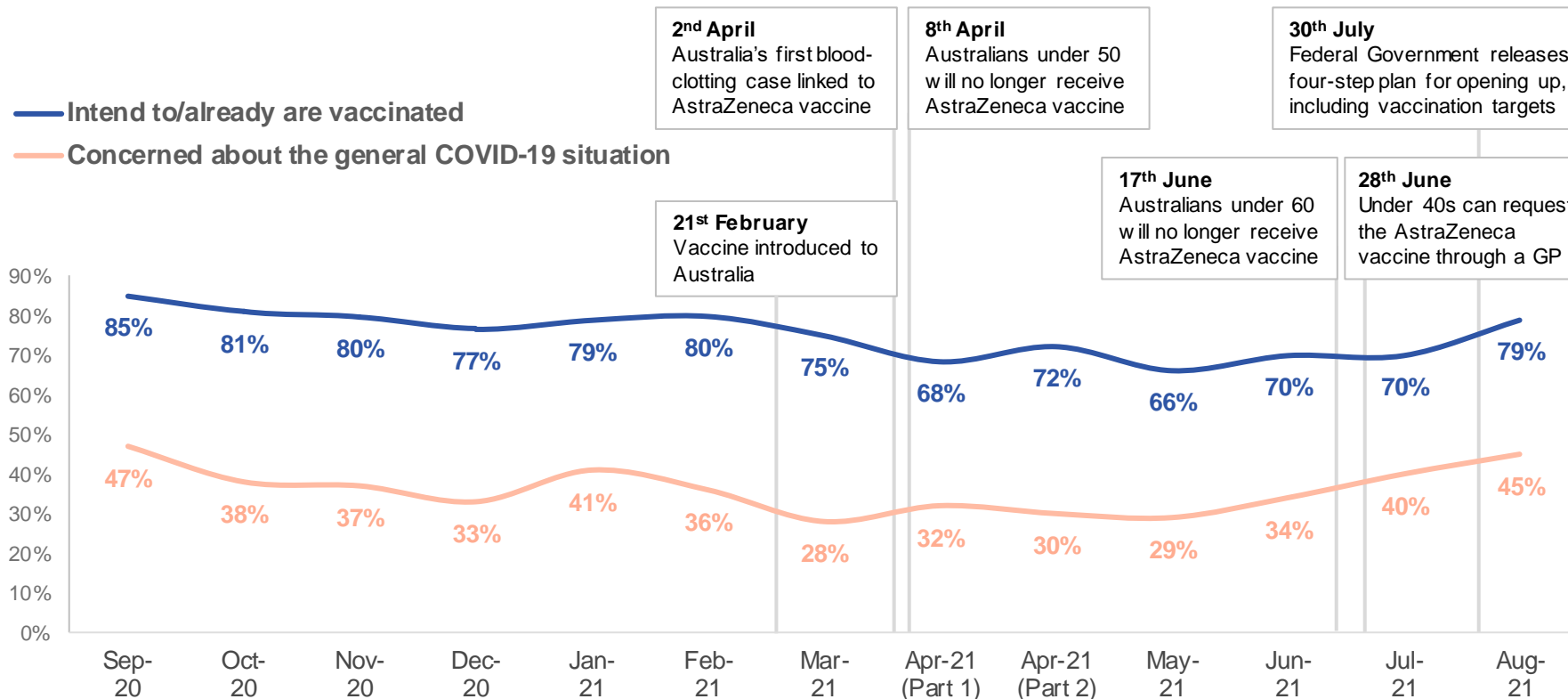


COVID-19 Vaccine Monitor: Summary (Aug-21)

- Community intentions to be vaccinated against COVID-19 have increased significantly in August, with 79% likely to get, or already are, vaccinated.
- Concern about the general COVID-19 situation has increased for the third consecutive month.



Base (if not indicated otherwise): All Australians, n=1,000 per wave, measured in the **first week of the month** (in April data was collected in the first two weeks).
 *Base: Not yet vaccinated against COVID-19 (n=750 Aug-21). ^Base: Not very/not at all likely to get vaccinated against COVID-19 (n=209 Aug-21)

Have the recent COVID-19 outbreaks prompted you to...?

Consider being vaccinated: **36%**
 Book a COVID-19 vaccination: **18%**
 Go and actually get vaccinated: **21%**

Consider the AstraZeneca vaccine: **17%**
 Speak to my GP about the AZ vaccine: **12%**
 Book an appointment for the AZ vaccine: **8%**
 Go and get the AZ vaccine: **11%**

Top 3 concerns about being vaccinated*

Unsure of the long-term side effects: **41%**
 Development process feels rushed: **30%**
 I feel that there is inadequate testing/research: **29%**

Top 3 motivators for considering vaccination^

Confidence in safety: **35%**
 If large numbers around the world safely vaccinated: **16%**
 If I was more at-risk health wise: **14%**
