# Metadata

**People with at least one dose.** The count of all people who have received at least one dose of an eligible vaccine. People with at least one dose encompasses people fully vaccinated and people with only one dose.

**People fully vaccinated.** Total people fully vaccinated with 2 doses of the same vaccine type.

**AIR Population.** A distinct count of persons recorded on the Australia Immunisation Register.

**Statistical Area Level 4 (SA4).** Geographic boundaries established as part of the Australian Statistical Geography Standard (ASGS). SA4s are required to have large populations of over 100,000 people and are based around labour markets. SA4s are aggregations of whole Statistical Area Level 3 (SA3) boundaries and fit within whole state and territory boundaries.

## Update Information:

Vaccine data is sourced from the Australian Immunisation Register as at 11:59pm 7 September 2021 including individuals aged 15 and over.

AIR population is sourced from the Australian Immunisation Register as at 11:59pm 7 September 2021 including individuals aged 15 and over.

## Data caveats

The indigenous population in the Australian Immunisation Register currently significantly overcounts the Indigenous population in Victoria due to a data quality issue being investigated.
