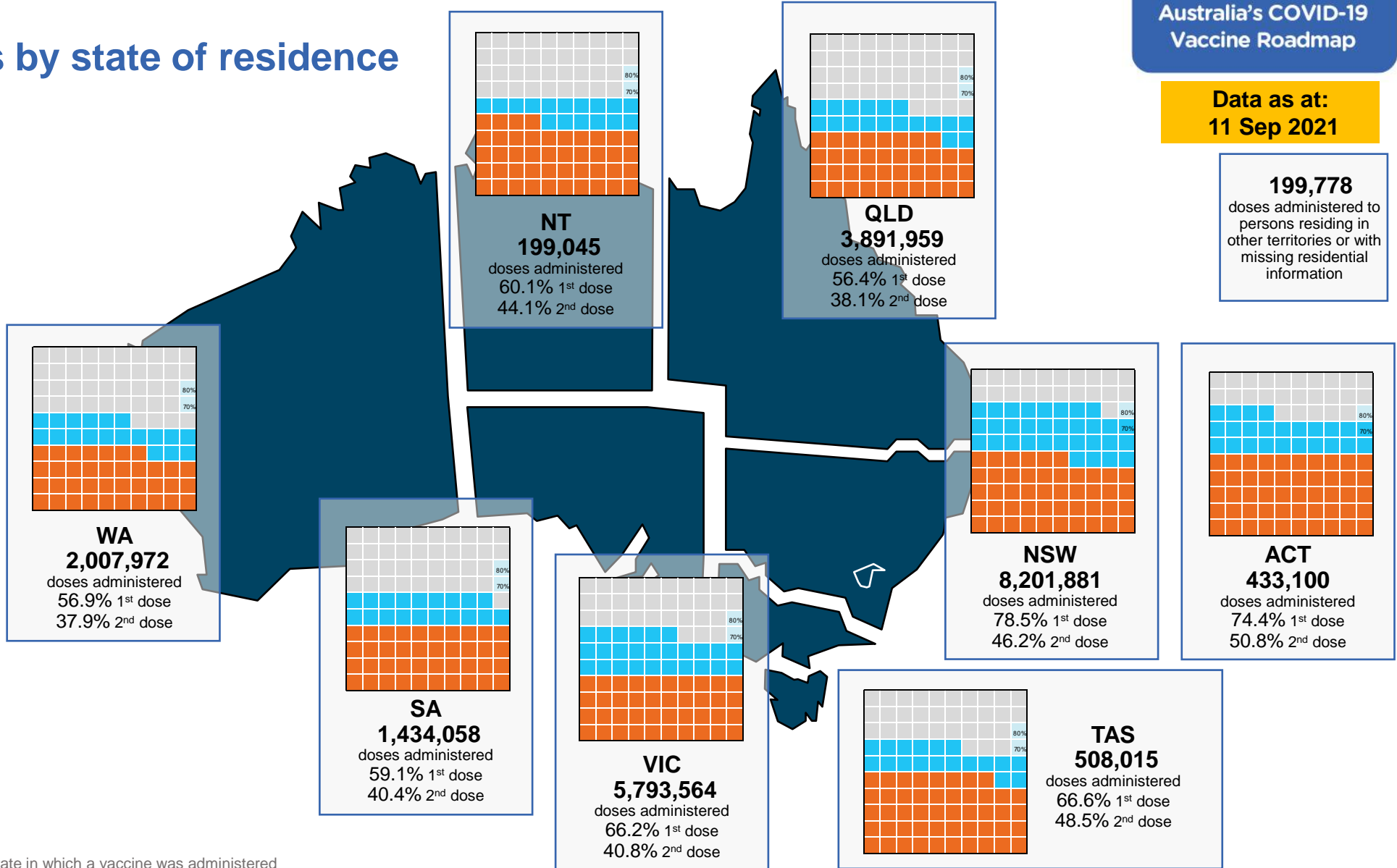

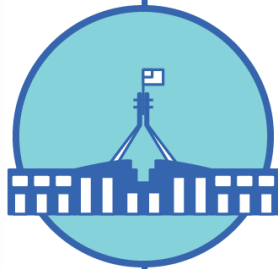

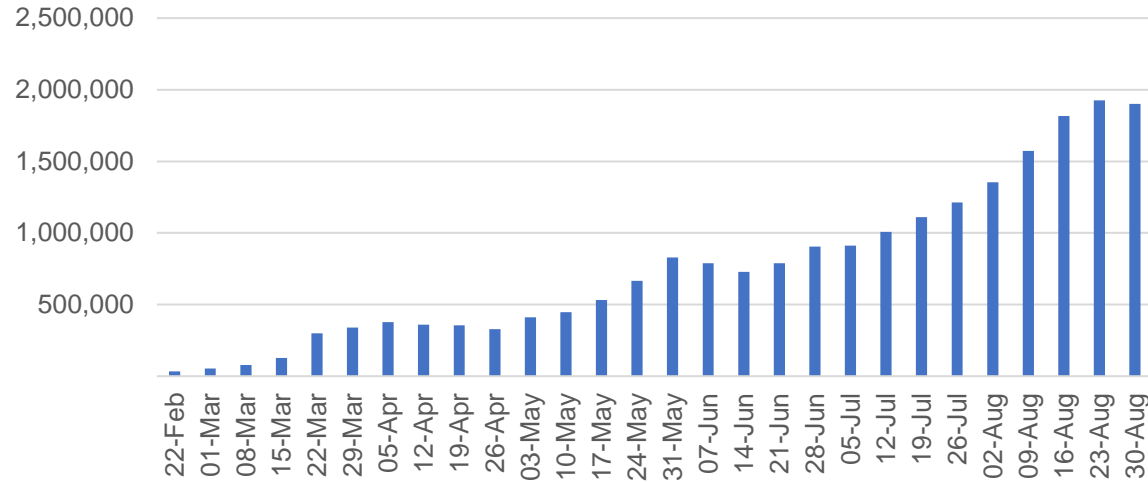

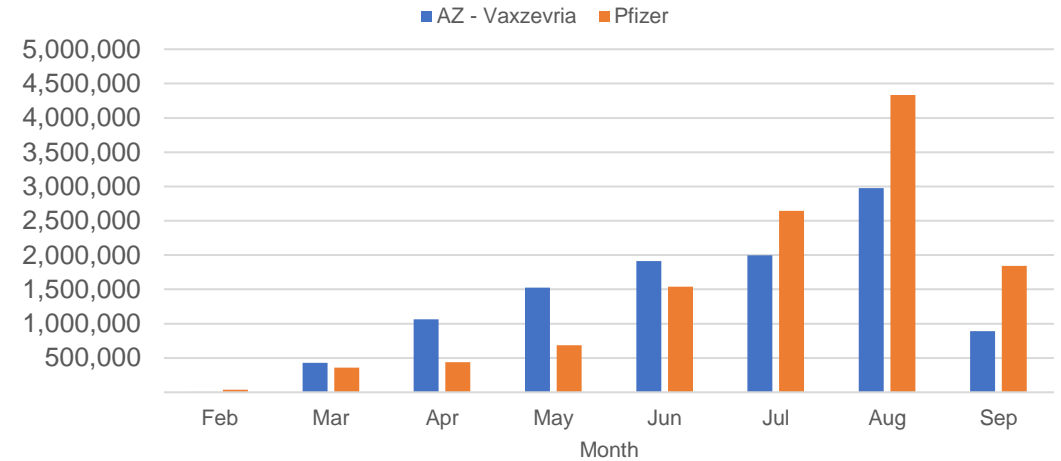

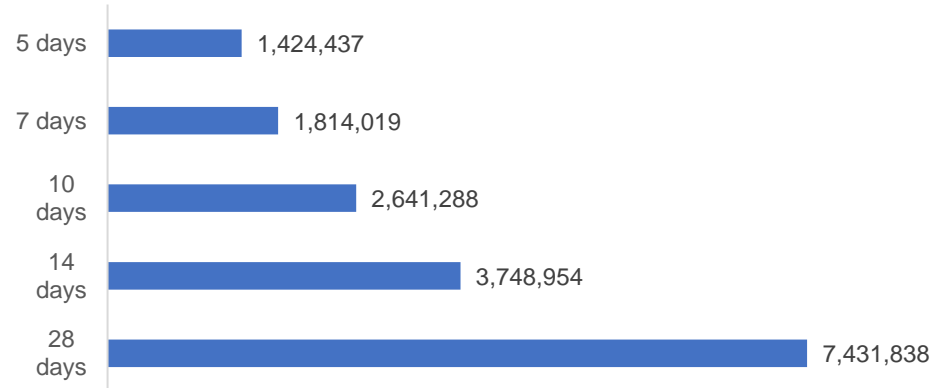
Jabs in arms by week



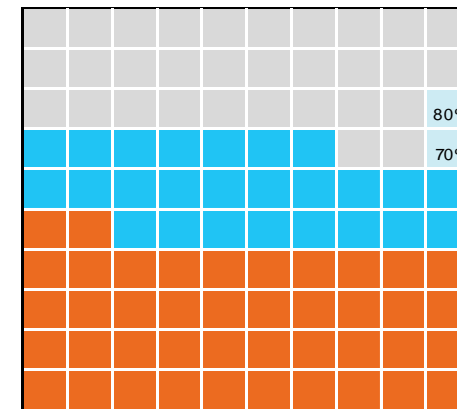
Doses by administration month and vaccine type

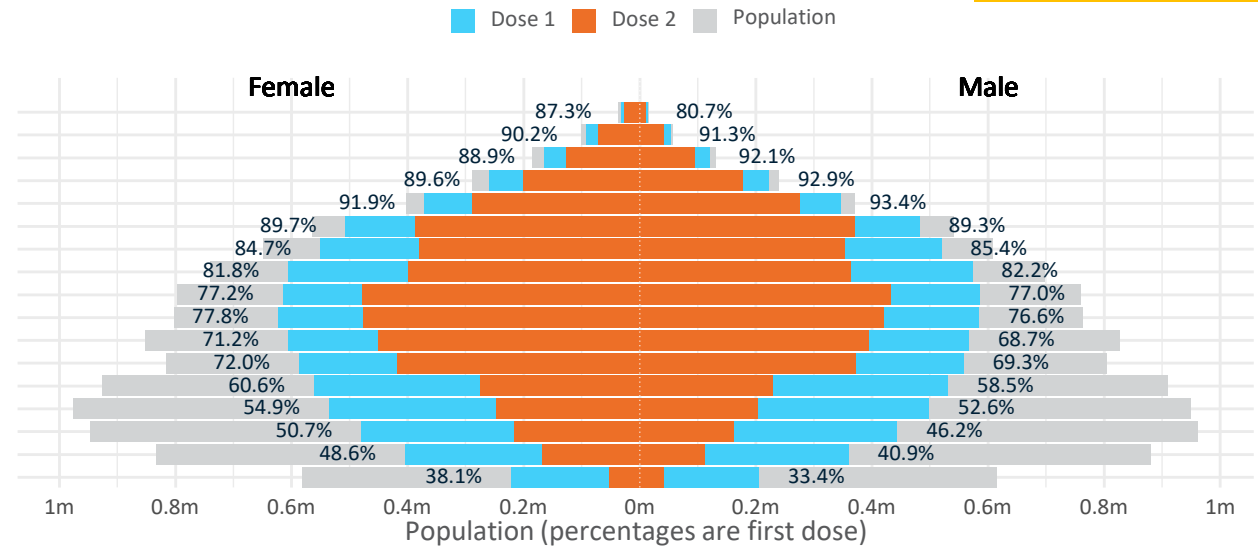

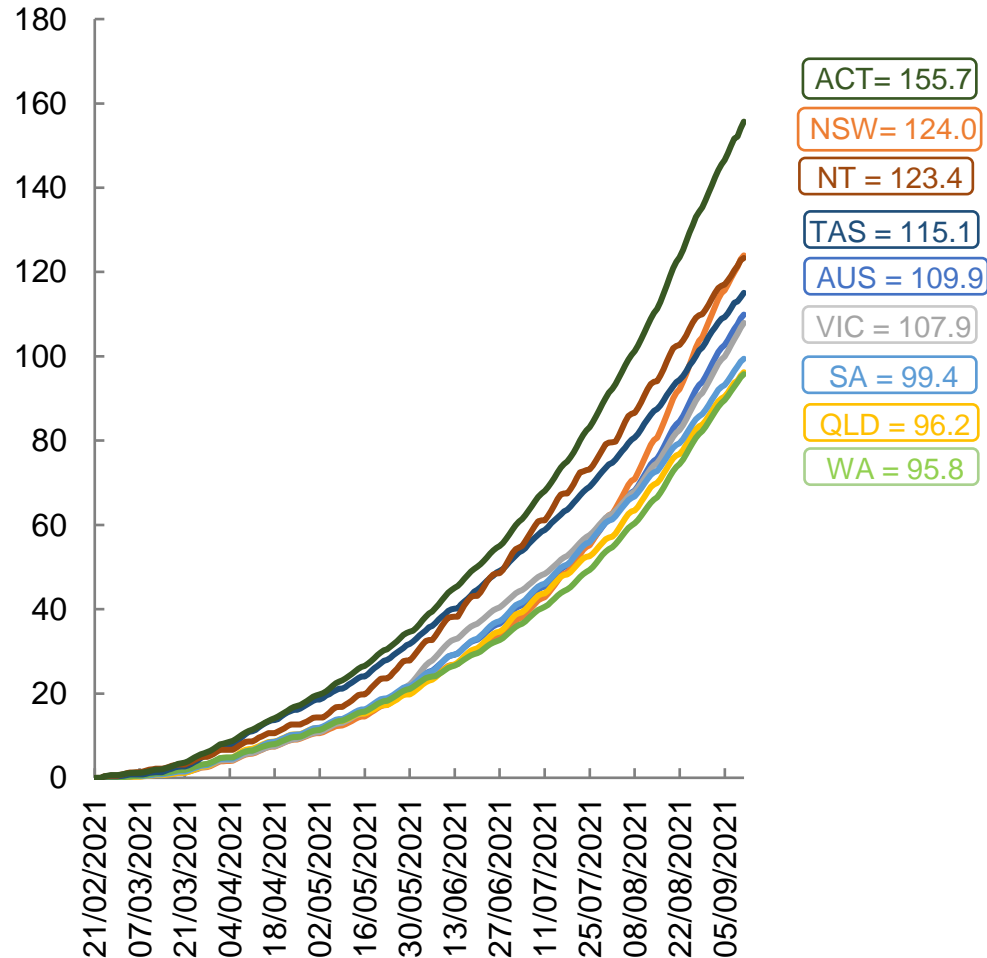

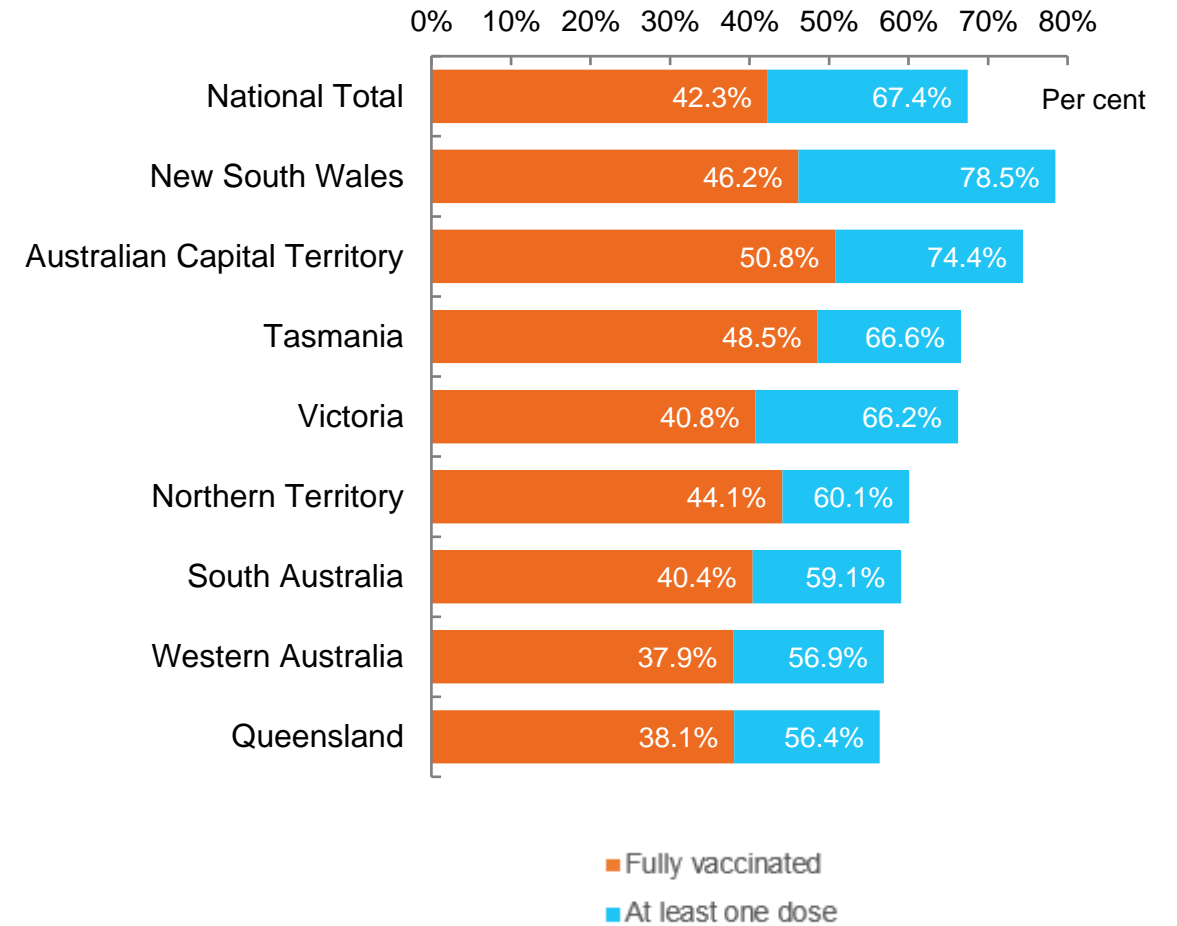

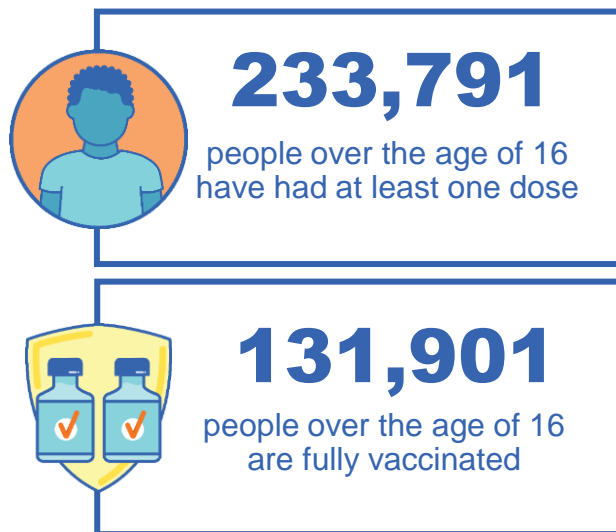

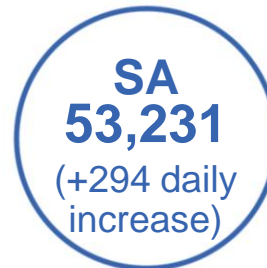
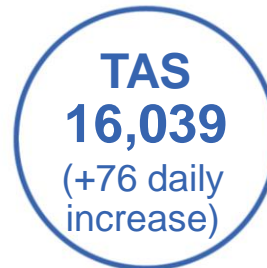

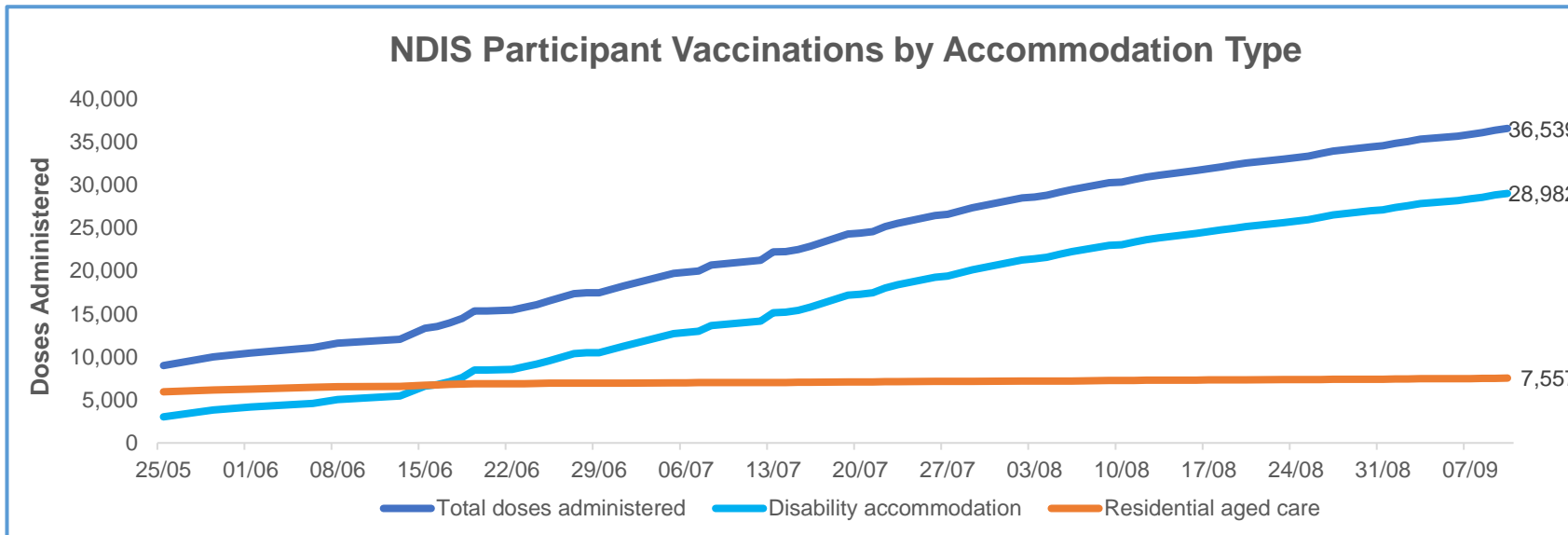

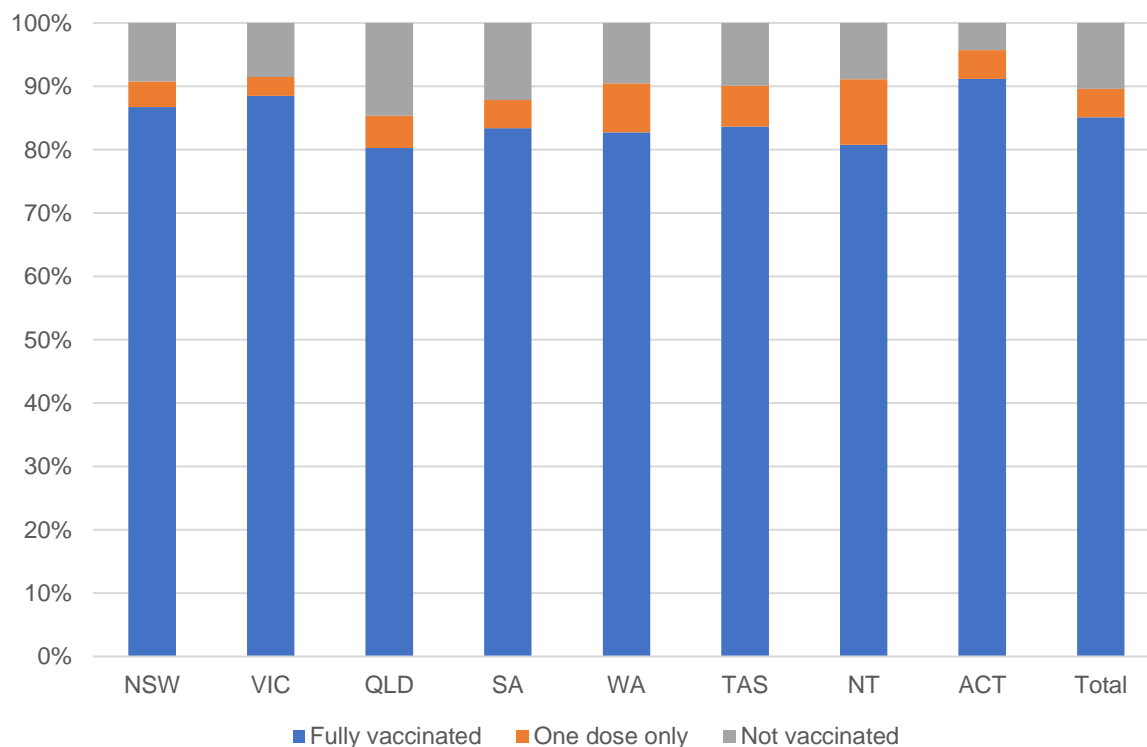

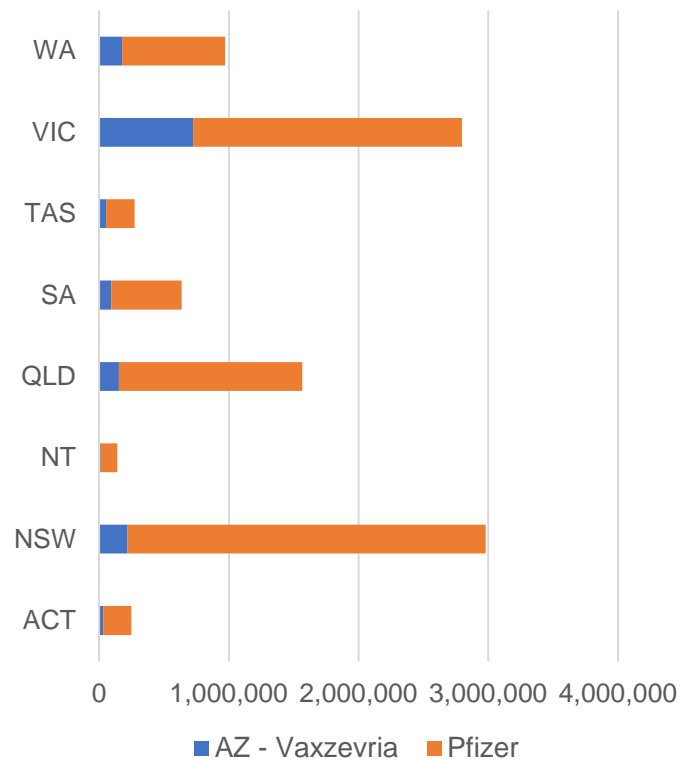

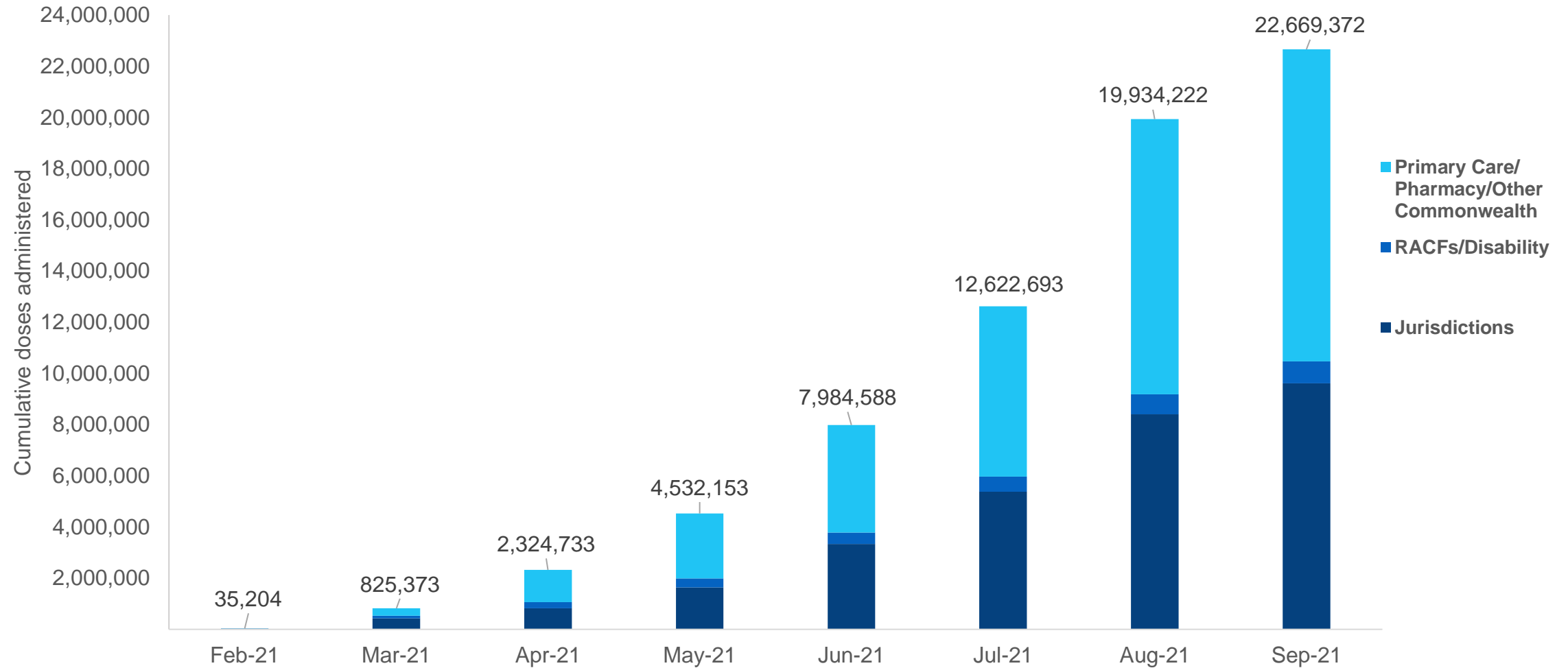

Cumulative doses administered by channel



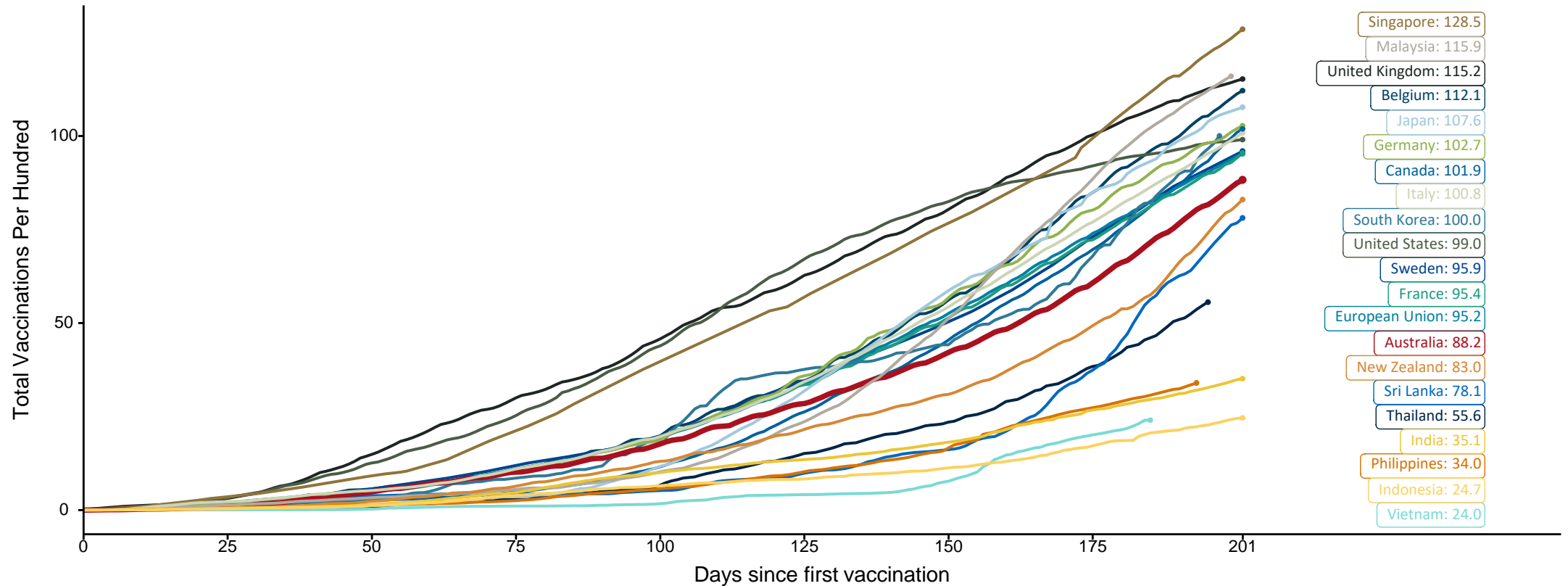

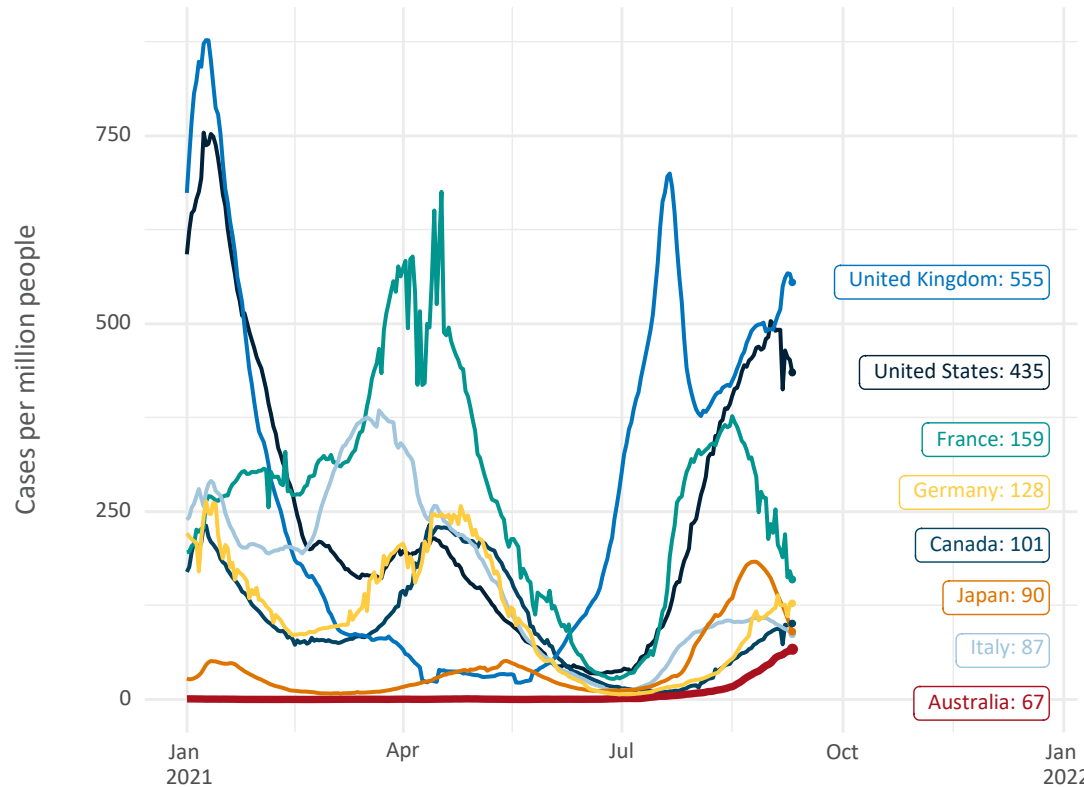

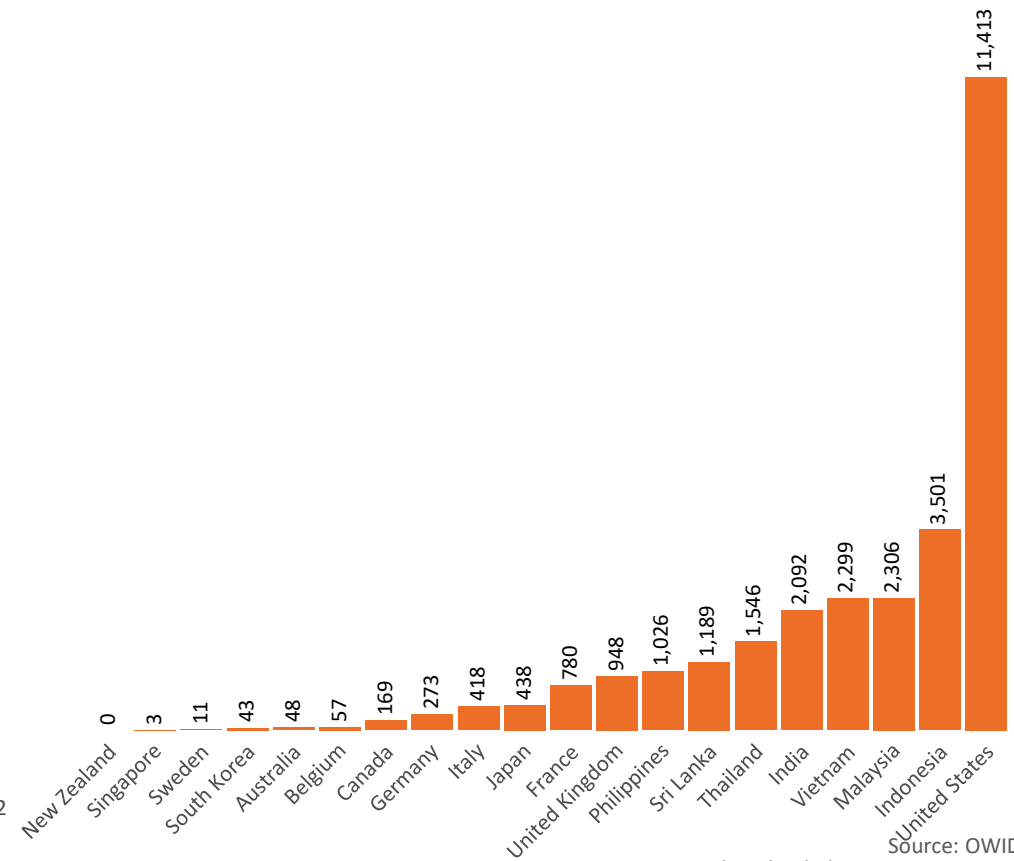
