















Vaccinations by location


Cumulative total doses administered vs state populations*












Doses at equivalent stages of rollout (Day 218)

Cumulative doses administered (28 Sep): 27,441,696






New daily cases per million in 2021, Australia and G7 countries Smoothed - 7 day average




